Terms and Conditions

- o Racks must be rented from the Guilford Parks and Recreation Department on a seasonal basis.
- o Boats are not permitted in the swimming area at Jacobs Beach.
- o All boats stored at Jacobs Beach must be kept in their assigned boat rack. Two boats may be kept in the same rack for an additional cost. Boats are not allowed to impede other racks space.
- o All boats must be removed from the boat rack by **Sunday, November 10th**. Failure to do so will result in a \$75.00 fine, for the 1st two weeks. A \$50 fine per month will follow until picked up.
- o Vehicles are not permitted on beach or grass area to transport boats. Vehicles must stay in the parking area and boats must be transported by hand to designated boat rack.
- o Any boat found in violation of any of the above regulations will be subject to immediate removal from the boat racks. Any cost associated with such removal will be at the owner’s expense.

PARK & BEACH RULES

1. NO DOGS.
2. NO SMOKING ON BEACH AREA OR IN THE PARK.
3. NO BOATS, THIS INCLUDES TUBES, RUBBER BOATS AND AIR MATTRESSES.
4. PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES ARE PERMITTED AS LONG AS THEY ARE US COAST GUARD APPROVED. IF CHILD IS IN A PFD THEY STILL MUST BE IN REACH OF PARENT WHEN IN WATER
5. ALL SWIMMERS MUST STAY IN THE SWIM AREA. HANGING ONTO ROPES AT LAKE QUONNIPAUG IS NOT ALLOWED EXCEPT IN AN EMERGENCY.
6. UNNECESSARY ROUGH PLAY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
7. NO FISHING IN THE BEACH AREA
8. NO SNORKELS OR SCUBA EQUIPMENT IN THE SWIM AREA.
9. ALL SWIMMERS MUST WEAR SWIMSUITS.
10. NO SWIMMERS IN LONG PANTS.
11. NO ONE MAY WALK ON THE JETTY OR ROCKS AT JACOBS BEACH.
12. NO PLAYING WITH FRISBEES, BALLS, ETC. IN THE BEACH AREA AT LAKE QUONNIPAUG.
13. PLEASE CARRY OUT ALL LITTER.
14. NO GLASS IN BEACH AREA.
15. BUSSES MUST GET A PERMIT FROM THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT.
16. THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CLOSE THE BEACHES DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS OR OVERCROWDING.
17. BEACHES CLOSE AT DUSK OR AT TIMES POSTED BY THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT.
18. AN ADULT MUST CLOSELY SUPERVISE ALL CHILDREN.
19. SWIMMING IS ALLOWED ONLY WHEN A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY.
20. NO SWIMMING AT JACOB'S BEACH BEYOND THET JETTY IS PERMITTED.
21. NO TENTS/GRILLS/PINICS ALLOWED IN PARKING LOT AREA.
