

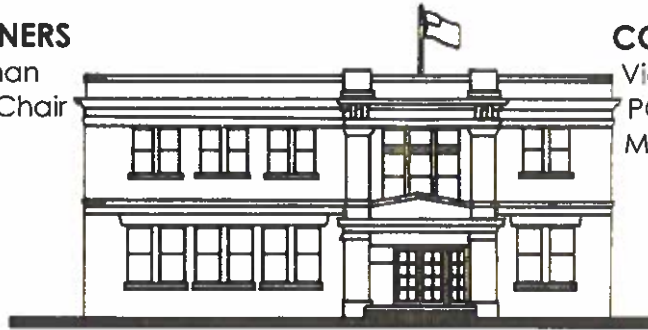

HARDING COUNTY CATTLEGUARD POLICY

Effective March 16th, 2023; all cattle guards set in place on any or all county roads must meet spec's as listed below:

Minimum spec's 18' x 7' x 20''

Unit constructed of 2 3/8 pipe or bigger

4" I beam, or standard railroad iron must be contained in a box with sheet metal

Unit may be placed in concrete box with removeable grids

Unit placed on timbers is also suitable meeting the required depth of 20" deep (*timbers must be provided by customer)

12" high, side pipe railing with 6 1/2 pipe up right for fence or gate placement

Removeable wings

Road Crew will help installing these structures with equipment ect.
