

COVID PROTOCOLS IN NM COURTHOUSES

We suggest you call the court prior to visiting the courthouse – 575 673-2252

Any person entering a New Mexico courthouse or judicial building must wear a mask, be screened and practice social distancing to help control the spread of COVID-19.

“State health officials have made it abundantly clear that if each of us wears a mask in public we can help slow the spread of COVID-19 and save lives,” said Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura. “Our courts provide essential services to the public, so we continue to take all steps necessary to safeguard the health and well-being of people who work in or need to visit a courthouse.”

****To access the 2nd floor (the courtroom floor):**

From the 1st floor staircase, please call 575 673-2252 or ring the bell on the staircase, to contact court staff.

Screening questions will be administered.

Name and contact information will be gathered.

When instructed move the No Touch thermometer for a temp check.

Hold forehead or wrist 2” – 4” from the No Touch thermometer.

Staff will give further instructions as needed.
