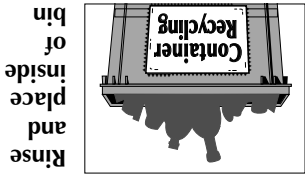

No light bulbs, window glass, dishes, glasses, and Pyrex.
 No paint cans, unmarked plastic or Styrofoam packing.
 No plastic bags – Return to grocery store.

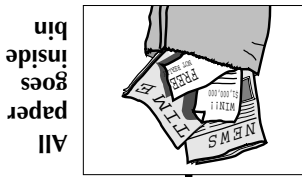
- Deposit and non-deposit beverage and aerosol cans, jars and bottles made of glass, metal, or plastic #1-5, & 7
- Food, beverage, soap, and household cleaning containers
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- Leave on caps and rings from all containers.
- Labels may be left on. Crush plastic bottles.
- Empty aerosol cans.



Containers

No foil, wax, cellophane or Styrofoam mixed with cardboard.

- Newspapers/ inserts
- Office, note and copy paper
- Junk mail, phone books and magazines – Remove cellophane, foil & wrappings.
- Chipboard – Cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc., remove plastic liners.
- Corrugated cardboard – Flatten, size to 2' x 2' or smaller and bundle.
- All paper and cardboard must be clean.

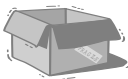
