Payment of Bills: Kanabec County Auditor - \$672.00 Kanabec County Times - \$351.71

Old Business:

SWCD: Nick from SWCD attended the meeting regarding the manure pit. The pit was built in 1979 and was constructed with a concrete liner. It has a 335,000 capacity of which was half filled at last usage in 2018. It is 1200 feet away from Knife Lake. The property owner is looking for assistance in the closing of the pit with an approximate, high end, cost of \$36,000.00. The property owner has started a federal application for assistance. The funding if received would be approximately \$6,600.00 leaving a balance due of \$29,400.00. The Snake River Board has approved \$15,000.00 which is good through 2021 which would leave a balance of \$14,000.00. Kekegama Lake has offered to donate \$3,000.00 leaving a balance of \$11,000.00. KLID is not funded by the county but by the property owners. The property owner is choosing to close the pit and not being forced to close. Kyle will talk to the Sportsman's Club regarding the funding. The board will continue discussion of donation at May Board Meeting.

Dam Insurance: Kyle has no new information and Kris McNally is still working on it.

Aerators: Per Kyle, there needs to be more volunteers to work on placement of the aerators. He has requested as many board members as possible work on the placement. He has not been contacted by Leslie George and has an understanding the he will only be contacted if the oxygen level is low. DNR is checking weekly. Per Ray Mattson Electric needs to complete work at his property site in the spring.

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River: The contract has been signed and is being delivered to Mr. Rosnow via certified mail. Soil and Water has sent an easement letter to Gene Carda which is expected to be signed after Mr. Rosnow signs his letter. The Board will wait to hear from Mr. Rosnow.

Weeds: Per Terry, \$3,300.00 grant has been received from DNR. He has contacted the sprayer regarding the work. There will be a \$1,000.00 charge due to Dan Swanson for an inspection.

AIS: Per Kyle, KLID received \$3,800.00 from AIS. He has requested additional funds. Terry will look into pull tabs to help with funding.

Insurance Audit: Ray is working on the audit. Ray has obtained new tax ID #'s and passwords for the Board.
