

**BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MINUTES
OF
August 10, 2015**

The regular meeting of the Brunswick Town Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall on Monday August 10, 2015 at 7 p.m. The following were in attendance. Rick Kawalek, Craig Peterson, Shari Hartog, and Ron Peterson. Jeff Akkerman and Steve Johnson absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Rick Kawalek and the flag pledge was said.

- M/S/C by Kawalek to approve the agenda with addition of cutting road ditches.
- Clerk Peterson read the minutes of the July 13, 2015 regular board meeting..
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2015 board meeting.
- M/S/C by Kawalek that Treasurer's report of total cash available \$268,737.50 is filed for audit.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson, to pay the claims. C. Peterson aye, Kawalek aye. Akkerman absent.
- Rodney Minnich reported about the traffic on Lumber Street by his house. The density and speed of the traffic is excessive considering the narrowness and the height of Lumber Street across the swamp north of his property. He also asked for dust control and control of traffic spinning doughnuts at the intersection.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to post signs on Lumber Street noting the narrow road and establishing a speed limit.
- Road Ditches: It was noted that the road ditches were not cut on 130th Ave. from Kanabec #12 to the South Fork line.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to certify to the Kanabec County Auditor the following assessments for unpaid fire calls: David & Robin Hodges, 1518 Lumber Street, \$1,175.00 plus 10% penalty of \$117.50 and David Swanson, 2074 127th Avenue, \$500.00 plus 10% penalty of \$50.00. Further, the penalties will not apply if the overdue amounts are paid into Brunswick's treasury within 30 days.
- Discussion of plugged culvert in Lewis Lake Dr. led to the possibility that there is a second culvert further up from the lake.
- M/S/C by C. Peterson to adjourn at 8:35 p.m.
