The regular meeting of Brunswick Township Board of Supervisors was held at the Town Hall in Brunswick on Monday February 13th, 2017. The minutes were approved with these changes. The Treasurer Report was read by Shari Hartog. M/S/C by Craig second by Jeff to file for audit.

BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

Rick Kawalek started out with a discussion on Terry Nielson. Planning commission had a meeting and denied the IUP for the hot mix plant. Terry asked in writing for 60 day extension for finding of facts. M/S/C by Rick and second by Jeff to grant Terry Neilson 60 day extension. That will put the Date out to May 11th 2017.

Hardrives Inc. did reply to us with in the twenty days with the information. Sharon King asked wasn't that a twenty day notice to comply with the things on the list. One of them was to remove that piece of equipment and it is still there. Del spoke up on the CUP permit also. Del submitted a citizen's petition; this is a state environmental impacted study. This is a state ordinance that should be done on the property Hardrives Inc, has put their name on all partials Terry Nielson owns. Del said this is just for the IUP permit.

Dennis McNaley asked some questions on who can ask for more time on something like this, and what about the oath you all took to put the health wealth and safety of the people of Brunswick first. There was talk about a special meeting, but after giving Terry the 60 days no special meeting was needed. If there is any medical documentation from a doctor about being very harmful to the people living around that area the people should bring it to the Planning Commission. There will be a Planning Commission Meeting.

Rick signed the contract for the City of Ogilvie Fire Department.

The board needs to set the levy to be recommended to the public at the annual town meeting on March 14th 2017.
