

Brunswick Township *Approved Meeting Minutes*
Monday- - December 12, 2022

Call to Order: Chair Rick Kawalek called the meeting of the Brunswick Board of Supervisors to order at 6:00 PM. Flag pledge was said. The following were in attendance: Supervisors, Rick Kawalek, Peter Gravich, Jeff Akkerman; Clerk, Gladys Nelson; Treasurer, Shari Hartog; Zoning Administrator, John Teichroew.

Agenda: Peter made motion to approve the agenda; second by Rick. Motion carried (3-0).

Clerk Report: Gladys read the minutes from November 7, 2022 Special Board of Supervisors meeting; and minutes from November 14, 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting. Motion by Jeff; second by Rick to approve. Motion carried (3-0).

Treasurer Report/Claims: The treasurer reported total cash of \$ 477,603.88 as of November 30, 2022. A motion by Jeff to approve the treasurer report and file for audit; seconded by Rick. Motion carried (3-0). A motion by Peter; second by Rick to pay the claims. Motion carried (3-0). (Total of claims paid December 12, 2022: \$ 2,735.20 ; check # 7739-7750).

New / Old Business:

*****Zoning:** Town received application for Interim CUP. Application forwarded to John for review. In review, it is noted that needs to be 2 separate applications to comply with current Zoning Ordinance. Clerk was asked to write letter to applicant with instructions to change response to question # 3 of application (one application to be for mining; one application to be for crushing). When second application received along with \$ 700.00 fee John will review. When approved, the 60 days will begin and a date for a Public Hearing will be established.

*****Misc:** Discussion was held to see if any changes to fee schedule. Motion by Jeff; seconded by Rick to adjust Land Use Permit fee for accessory buildings to \$ 75.00. The new rate to begin January 1, 2023. Motion carried (3-0) No Change Board of Supervisors Meeting – 2nd Monday of Month – start 6:00 pm. Motion by Rick; seconded by Peter to add the following to Board minutes.

The lawsuit brought against the township by Mr. Peterson has been resolved favorably for the township. A referee found that the township did not violate the Data Practices Act in charging Mr. Peterson for the data he requested. The appeal period has expired so this matter should be resolved. Motion carried (3-0)
