

Brunswick Township Approved Meeting Minutes

Monday- - February 14, 2022

Call to Order: Chair Rick Kawalek called the meeting of the Brunswick Board of Supervisors to order at 6:00 PM. The following were in attendance: Supervisors, Rick Kawalek, Peter Gravich, Jeff Akkerman; Clerk, Gladys Nelson; Treasurer, Shari Hartog; Zoning Adm., John Teichroew.

Agenda: Peter made motion to approve the agenda; second by Jeff. Motion carried (3-0).

Clerk Report: Gladys read the minutes from January 10, 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting. Rick made a motion to approve minutes; seconded by Jeff. Motion carried (3-0).

Treasurer Report/Claims: The treasurer reported total cash of \$ 445,665.45 as of January 31, 2022. Motion by Peter to approve the report and file for audit; seconded by Jeff. Motion carried (3-0). A motion by Peter; second by Rick to pay the claims. Motion carried (3-0). (Total of claims paid on February 14, 2022 was \$ 41,479.27; check # 7576-7590)

Comments from the Floor: County Commissioner, Denny McNally reported on the Kanabec County Ditch # 2 project and how it will impact several township residents. There will be more meetings and information coming in the future.

*****Town Board Reorganization:**

Motion by Jeff; second by Peter that Supervisor Kawalek remain Chair and Weed Supervisor; Supervisor Gravich remain as Vice Chair; and Supervisor Akkerman remain as Road Chair. Motion carried. (3-0)

Motion by Jeff; second by Peter that the Second Monday of the month at 6:00 pm remain for Board meeting. No changes to the legal newspaper, bank depository or posting place. Motion carried. (3-0)


Motion by Jeff; second by Peter to set the hourly wage for the Supervisors and Election Judges at \$ 25.00 per hour. Motion carried. (3-0)

*****Levy:** Motion by Peter, second by Jeff to recommend to the residents at the Annual Meeting held on March 8th to set the 2023 Levy at General Fund-\$ 40,000.; Road and Bridge-\$ 80,000.; Fire-\$ 36,000. for a total of \$ 156,000. Motion carried. (3-0)


Roads: A discussion was held regarding sending notices to residents about fences on their property within the road right-of-way.
