Training: Caregivers with 0 - 5 years of licensure or experience as an adult foster home caregiver must complete 12 hours of county social service agency approved training a year. Caregivers with 6 or more years of licensure or experience as an adult foster home caregiver must complete 6 hours of training a year.

Exception: Caregivers providing not more than 30 cumulative days of foster care in a 12 month period and caregivers providing foster care eight hours or less a week.
