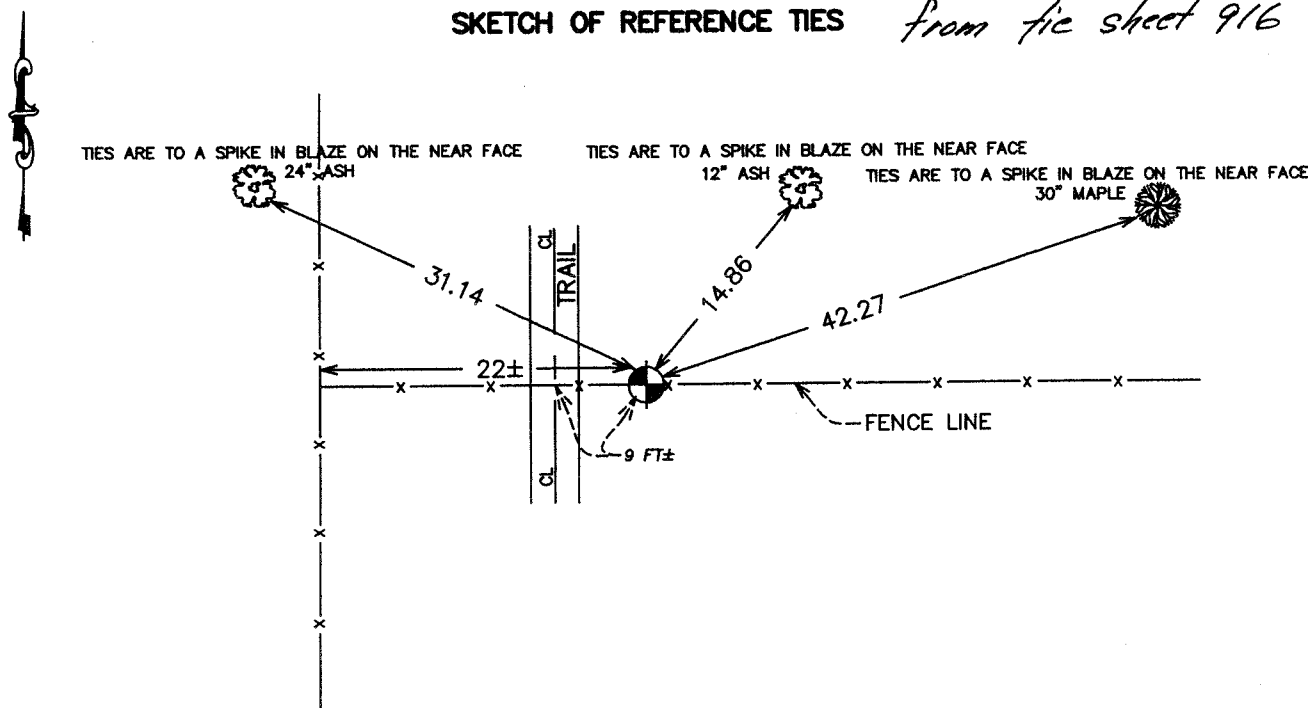

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE
(FROM TIE SHEET 916)

All of the original government bearing trees are now gone.

In January of 1995, we ran a survey around Section 14, Township 38, Range 24, to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and search areas.

This corner falls in the location of an east-west-north-south fence.

A search was made in this area, but no evidence was found.

We extended the line from the north quarter corner through the found stone with the cross mark at the center of Section 14 and found the location to be within 1 foot of a split of the north line of Section 23.

The location of this line intersected with the east-west fence was accepted as the best available evidence of the perpetuated location of the original corner.

(2003)

In May 2003, we ran a survey around Section 14 and found the monument set by M.B. Rude. We established Kanabec County coordinates on this corner using G.P.S. equipment.
