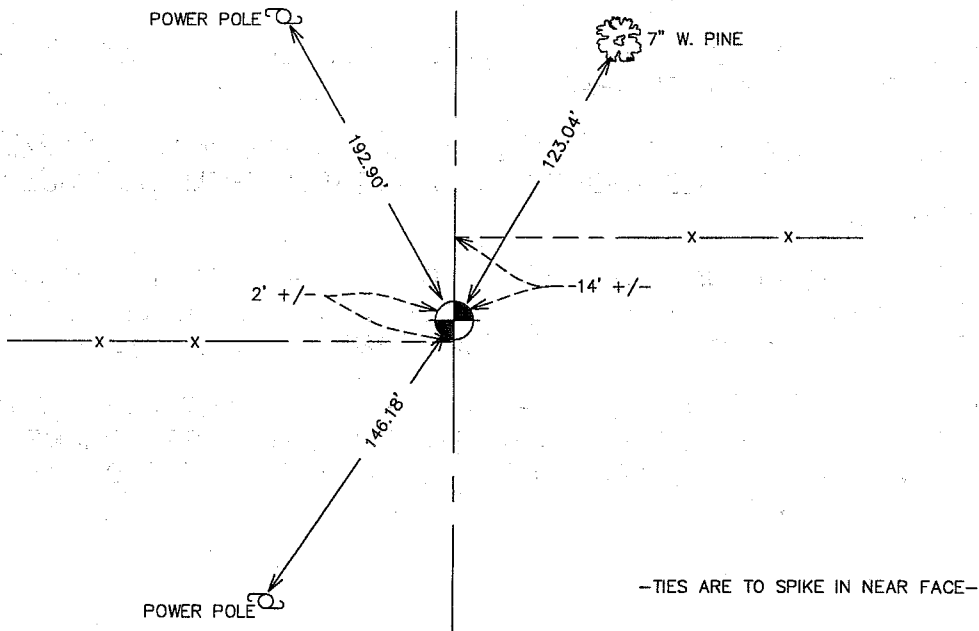

## STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE.

IN 1907, JON MULLEN MADE A ROAD SURVEY ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 7. THIS OWN ROAD SURVEY SHOWS THAT HE DID NOT FIND THE QUARTER CORNER AND RAN A STRAIGHT LINE FROM THE NORTHWEST TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF SECTION 7.

THE RECORDS OF THE FORMER COUNTY SURVEYOR, JAMES BUCKLEY, DATED IN 1927, SHOW A DISTANCE FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER TO THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 7, BUT NO MONUMENT IS SHOWN AT THE WEST QUARTER CORNER.

IN OCTOBER OF 1987, M.B. RUDE RAN A SURVEY ALONG THE WEST LINE OF TOWNSHIP 39, RANGE 22, TO LOCATE THE EXISTING MONUMENTS, LINES OF OCCUPATION AND SEARCH AREAS.

THIS CORNER LOCATION IS IN COUNTY HIGHWAY NO. 120 AND THERE IS A FENCE LINE EAST AND WEST 16 FEET APART.

ON OCTOBER 27, 1987, M.B. RUDE MADE AN EXCAVATION WITH THE BACKHOE AT BOTH FENCE LINES EXTENDED AND THE AREA BETWEEN THEM. NO EVIDENCE WAS FOUND IN THE EXCAVATION.

M.B. RUDE SET THIS CORNER ON A LINE AND SPLIT BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF SECTION 7. THIS LOCATION FITS THE CENTER LINE OF THE ROAD AND IS IN HARMONY WITH THE TOWN ROAD SURVEY OF 1907.

IN MARCH 2005 E.G. RUD AND SONS FOUND THIS MONUMENT AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ON THIS POSITION USING GPS EQUIPMENT. THIS POSITION IS WITHIN 0.20 OF A FOOT FROM A LINE AND SPLIT FROM NE AND SE CORNERS OF SECTION 12.
