

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL POST WAS SET BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR SILAS BARNARD ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1885 AND 2 BEARING TREES NOTED AS:

7" POPLAR BEARING N 20° W AT 15 LINKS

6" POPLAR BEARING N 40° E AT 20 LINKS

NO EVIDENCE FOR THE CORNER OR ACCESSORIES REMAIN TODAY.

THIS CORNER FALLS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD 65 AND AT THE INTERSECTION WITH A ROAD RUNNING SOUTH.

IN NOVEMBER 2014, E.G. RUD AND SONS, INC. DOING A SURVEY IN SEC. 23 FOUND A 1-1/2" BY 3' IRON PIPE BENT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD 65. THIS WAS THE SAME TYPE OF PIPE AS FOUND BY BOGART PETERSON AT THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER. A #7 REBAR 24" LONG WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP WAS SET, TIES WERE TAKEN AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION.
