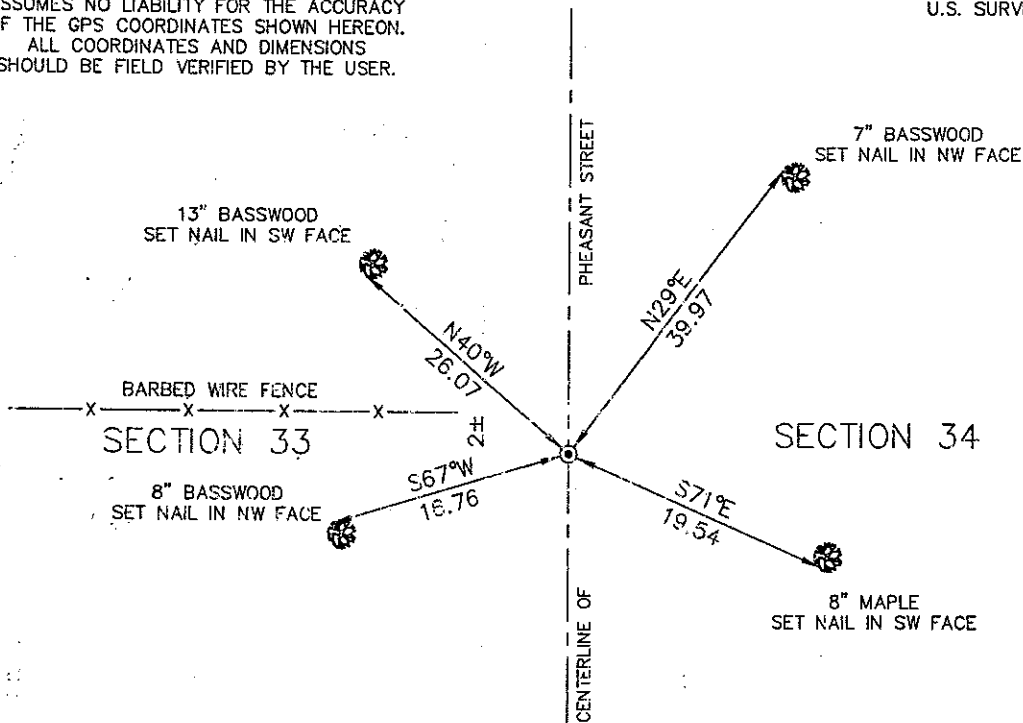

Statement of Evidence:

In August of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Silas Barnard set a post to mark the East Quarter Corner of Section 33, Township 39 North, Range 23 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

11 inch Ash at West a distance of 5 links

9 inch Ash at North 48 degrees East a distance of 8 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

1903—Comfort Township Road Order on record in the County Auditor's Office shows a survey by County Surveyor John Nelson along the West line of Section 34, T.39, R.23 for a township road. He gives a distance of 80.18 chains along the West line of Section 34. He does not state any information to the Quarter corner.

1904—County Surveyor John Nelson made a survey along the West line of Section 34, T.39, R.23, per the records of the County Highway Department. He gives a distance of 80.18 chains along the West line of Section 34. He does not state any information to the Quarter corner.

In October 2012, I made a survey around Section 34, Township 39 North, Range 23 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Christie Hershberger to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 10/18/2012, we made a 12' x 15' x 3.5' deep excavation with a front end loader at the road centerline and fence west. Approximately 1.5 feet down, we found a 1" x 12" Iron Pipe. I set a 1/2" x 24" Iron Pipe with Aluminum Cap in place of the found 1" Iron Pipe. Established reference ties and assigned Kanabec County coordinates.

This location was determined to be the best available evidence of the original government corner.



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
