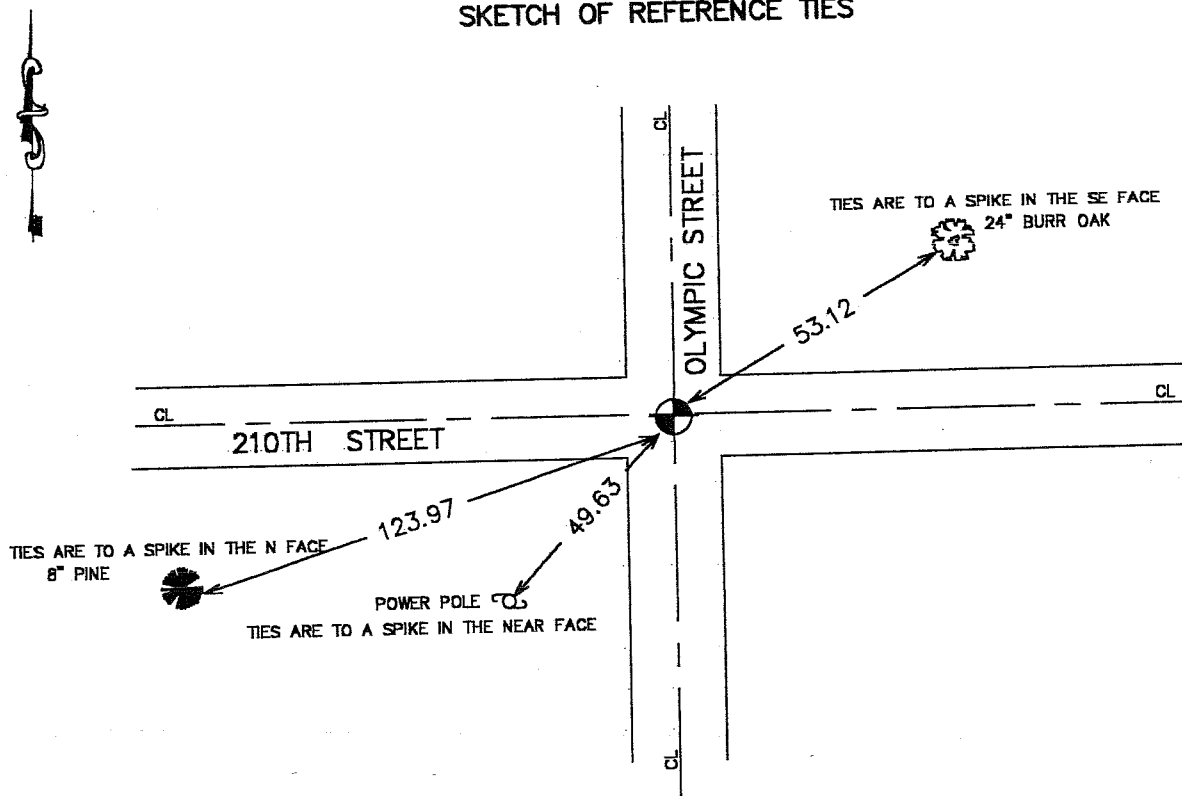

## STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

Original corner was set in September 1855 by Silas Barnard. Original bearing no longer remain.

John Nelson did a road survey along north line of Section 9 in December 1901. Records do not indicate what corner was set. In 1963 Gerald Sullivan did a survey in part of Section 9 and used the centerline of a north-south road and centerline of east-west road for the Section corner.

In 1998 E.G. Rud did a survey in the Northwest Quarter of Section 9 and found a half inch iron pipe with cap no.8195 indicating M.B. Rude had placed it. We tied this iron out and used it for the corner.

On October 23, 2002 we excavated a hole at the location of the pipe and at centerline / centerline. We found a 16 inch by 24 inch by 6 inch flat sandstone with a chiseled "x". This fell about 1 foot north of no.8195. We took ties and set monument.
