

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

Original corner was set in September 1855 by Silas Barnard. Original bearing no longer remain.

John Nelson did a road survey along north line of Section 9 and 10 in December 1901. Records do not indicate what corner was set. In 1963 Gerald Sullivan did a survey on part of Section 9 and used the centerline of a north-south road and centerline of east-west road for the Section corner.

In 1998 E.G. Rud set a half inch iron pipe at this intersection for a survey in the Northwest Quarter.

On October 23, 2002 we excavated a 20 foot by 15 foot by 3 foot deep hole at this intersection. Several stones were found in this excavation, but no stone had an "x" or other identifying mark to indicate it was set for this corner. We accepted Gerald Sullivans testimony and E.G. Rud's half inch iron pipe for the location of this corner. It fits well with occupation lines and measurements made by Gerald Sullivan. We set a Kanabec County Monument, took ties and established Kanabec County coordinates on said Section corner. A sandstone with a chiseled "x" was found at the Northeast and Northwest corner of Section 9. We measured 5301.17 feet between these ~~measurements~~ ^{monuments}. Gerald Sullivan measured 5303.40 feet. John Nelson's measurement was 5266.8 feet in 1901.
