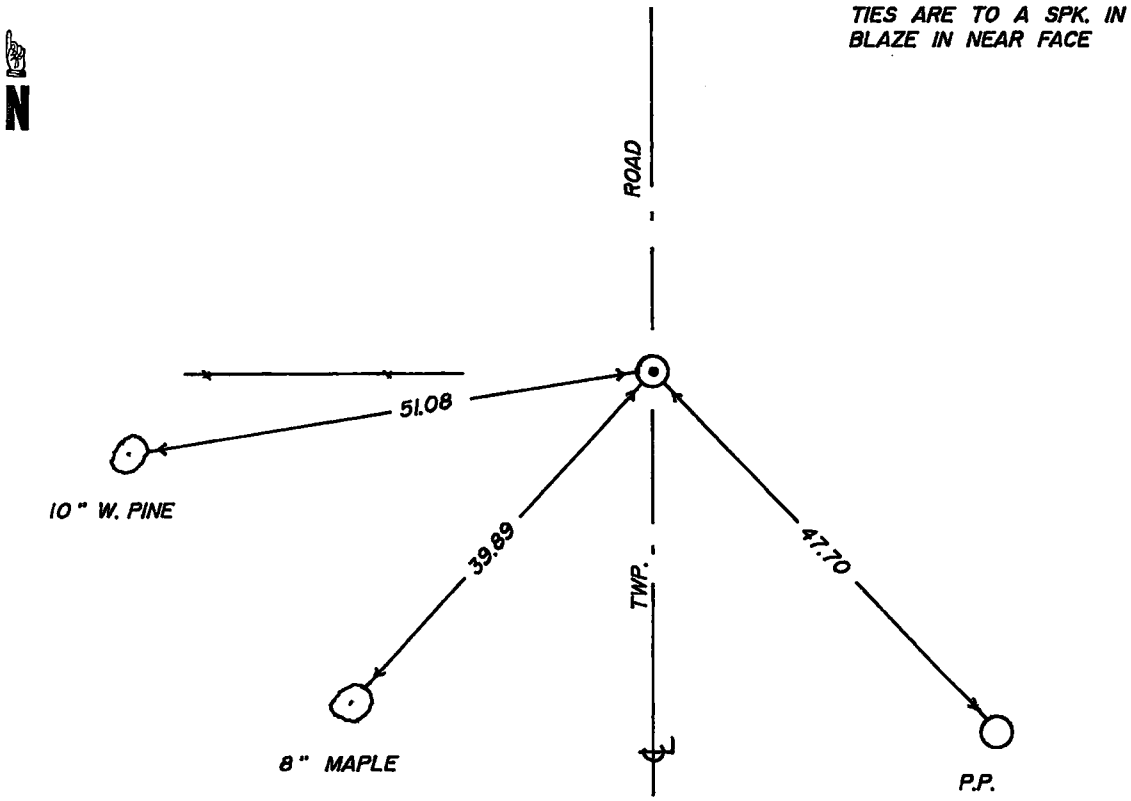

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

All of the original government ties are now gone.

In 1897, Thomas Vickery made a section subdivision of Section 20, Township 39, Range 23, and tied into a post at the north quarter corner of Section 20, Township 39, Range 23, per the records at the County Recorder's Office.

In September of 1995, we made a survey in Section 17, Township 39, Range 23, to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On October 3, 1995, we made a 3' by 12' by 14' excavation with a backhoe and found no additional evidence of this corner.

The center line of the existing road and old fence line west, extended east, was accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner location.

This location is in harmony with accepted lines of occupation.
