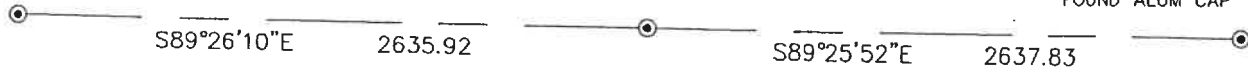

Statement of Evidence:

In October of 1857, Deputy Surveyor John M. Gay set a post to mark the North Quarter Corner of Section 32, Township 42 North, Range 23 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

- 7 inch Sugar at South 29 degrees East a distance of 11 links
- 7 inch Sugar at North 25 degrees East a distance of 14 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

In January 2019, I made a survey around Section 32, Township 42 North, Range 23 West, 4th Principal Meridian to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 1/10/2019, I made a search with a metal locator. Near a lost location, I found a 1/2" Iron Pipe marked LS 9808. I accepted the found Iron Pipe as the best available evidence of the original monument location and assigned Kanabec County Coordinates.
