

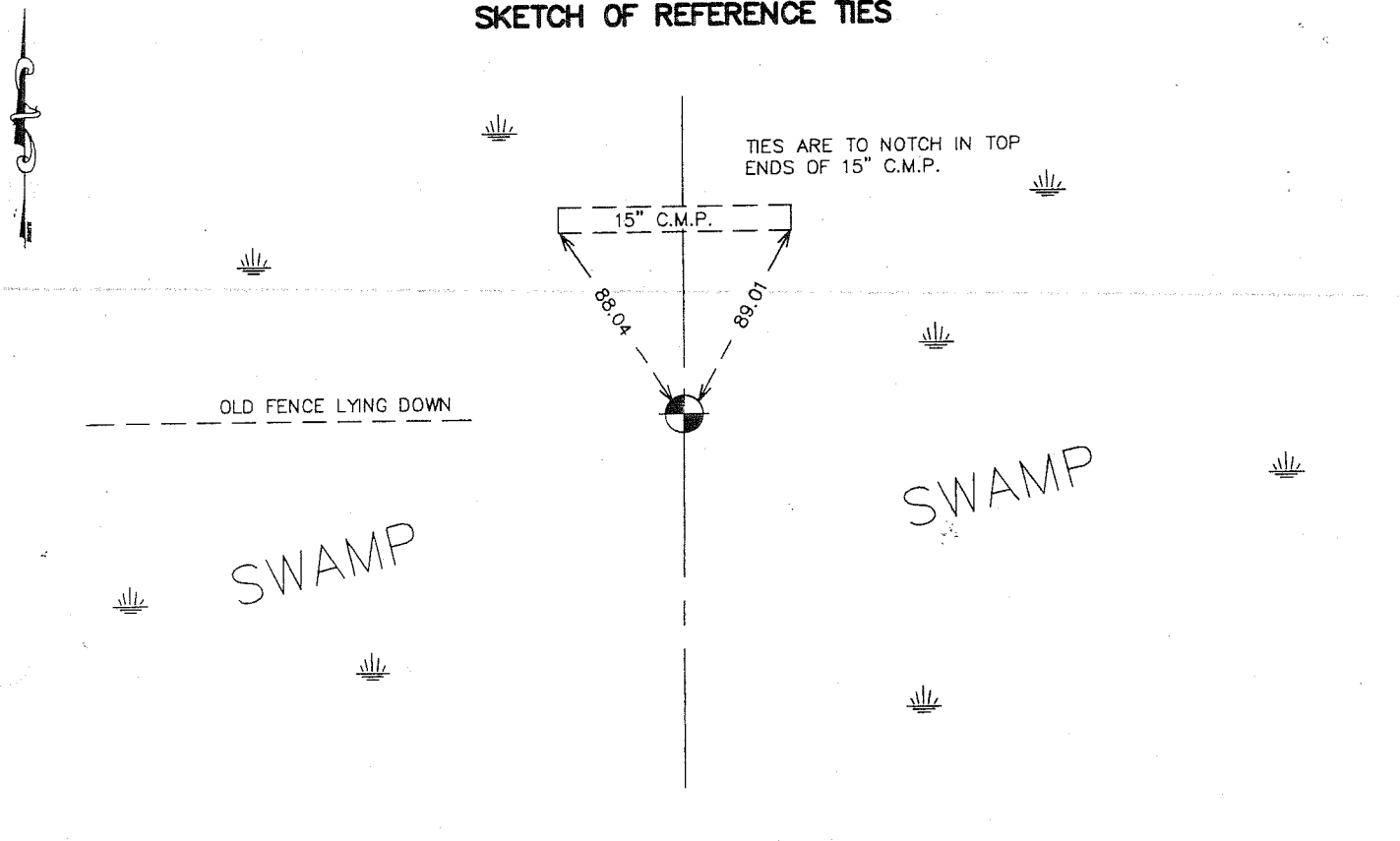

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE.

THERE IS A TOWN ROAD ORDER ON FILE DATED JANUARY 9, 1901, AND SURVEYED BY JOHN NELSON, STARTING AT THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 26 AND RUNNING SOUTH TO THE TOWN LINE A DISTANCE OF 8184 FEET.

THERE IS A NORTH-SOUTH ROAD AND AN OLD FENCE LINE WEST AT THIS LOCATION IN A SWAMP. NO EXCAVATION WAS MADE AS THE ROAD HAD BEEN CORDUROYED AND ALL EVIDENCE WAS DESTROYED.

IN APRIL OF 1988, M.B. RUDE RAN A SURVEY AROUND SECTIONS 23, 26, AND 35, TOWNSHIP 42 RANGE 24, TO LOCATE EXISTING MONUMENTS, LINES OF OCCUPATION AND SEARCH AREAS.

THE LOCATION OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD AND OLD FENCE LINE WEST EXTENDED EAST AND IS IN HARMONY WITH NELSON'S SURVEY FROM 1901 AND WAS ACCEPTED AS THE PERPETUATED LOCATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER LOCATION.

IN NOVEMBER 2006 E.G. RUD AND SONS FOUND AN ALUMINUM CAPPED REBAR AT THIS POSITION AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ON THE MONUMENT USING G.P.S. EQUIPMENT.
