



NORTHEAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 33, T42, R24

**STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE**

THE ORIGINAL POST WAS SET BY D.S. ISAAC BANKER ON DECEMBER 11, 1855 AND 4 WHITE PINES WERE ESTABLISHED AS BEARING TREES. NO EVIDENCE COULD BE FOUND FOR THE CORNER OR BEARING TREES. NO EVIDENCE COULD BE FOUND FOR THE CORNER OR BEARING TREES. NO RECORDS OF ANY SUBSEQUENT SURVEYS COULD BE FOUND AT KANABEC COUNTY OFFICES. NO ROAD OPENINGS ARE FILED EITHER.

IN OCTOBER 2006, E.G. RUD AND SONS RAN A SURVEY AROUND SECTIONS 19-21 AND 28-33. THIS CORNER WAS SET BY DOUBLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENTS BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33 AND NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34. A #7 REBAR WAS SET, REFERENCE TIES TAKEN AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION.
