

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 30, T42, R24

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER POST WAS SET BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR ISAAC BANKER ON DECEMBER 17, 1855 AND 2 SUGAR MAPLES WERE USED AS BEARING TREES. - NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE REMAINS FOR THE CORNER OR BEARING TREE.

NO SUBSEQUENT SURVEYS COULD BE FOUND THAT USED THIS CORNER AT THE KANABEC COUNTY OFFICES.

IN OCTOBER 2006 E.G. RUD AND SONS RAN A SURVEY AROUND SECTIONS 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 AND 33. NO LINE OF OCCUPATION COULD BE FOUND WITHIN 200 FEET.

THEREFORE THIS CORNER WAS SET BY SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT AND ON LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 30. A #7 REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP WAS SET, REFERENCE TIES TAKEN AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION.
