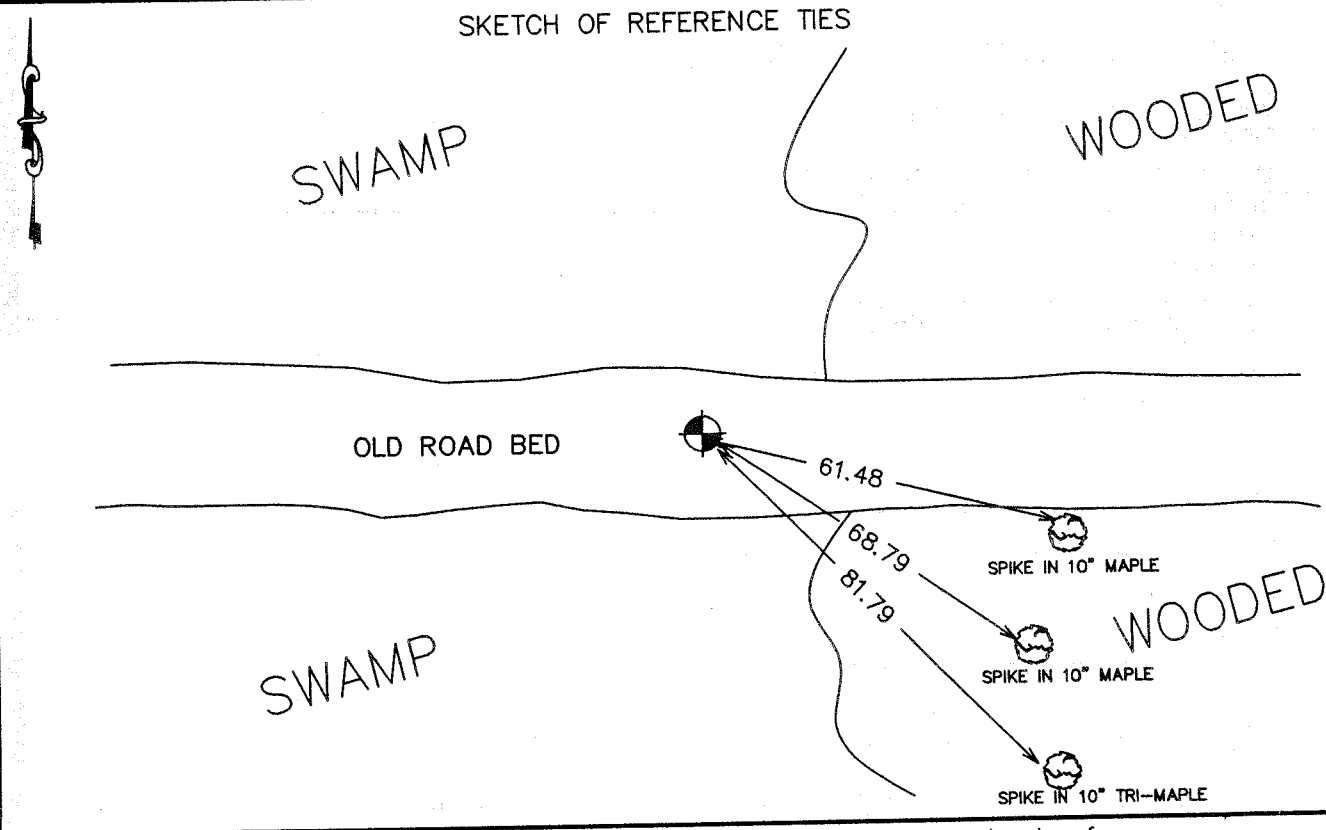

## STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

(2004)

Original corner was set by Deputy Surveyor Barber in December 1855. Evidence of original corner and bearing trees no longer remain.

Handschu did a survey of Sections 7 and 8 in 1933 and his notes show an iron pipe at this corner.

Curtis Stodel found this corner in 1982 and Kevin Fester found this corner in 2001.

We found this same iron pipe in June 2004 and established Kanabec County Coordinates on this position.
