

SE CORNER SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 24

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE.

THERE IS A ROAD ORDER ON FILE FROM 1904, FOR A 4 ROD ROAD LAID OUT FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23 TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24. THIS ROAD ORDER STATES THAT NO SURVEYOR WAS EMPLOYED IN THE LAYING OUT OF THE ROAD AS THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY WAS PLAINLY VISIBLE.

IN FEBRUARY 1979, M.B. RUDE RAN A SURVEY ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTIONS 22, 23 AND 24 AND LOCATED THE LINES OF OCCUPATION. THIS CORNER FALLS ON AN EAST-WEST COUNTY HIGHWAY AND FENCE LINE SOUTH AND NORTH.

THE COUNTY HIGHWAY PLANS SHOW THIS ROAD WAS REBUILT IN THE ORIGINAL LOCATION.

IN JULY 1980, M.B. RUDE MADE AN EXCAVATION WITH A BACKHOE AT THIS LOCATION. THE EXCAVATION WAS 15 FEET SQUARE, 4 FEET DEEP. NO EVIDENCE WAS FOUND IN THE EXCAVATION.

THE CENTER LINE OF THE EAST-WEST COUNTY HIGHWAY AND FENCE LINE NORTH AND SOUTH WAS ACCEPTED AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER LOCATION AS IT FITS THE ROAD ORDER LOCATION FROM 1904 AND THE ACCEPTED LINES OF OCCUPATION.

IN MARCH 2009, E.G. RUD AND SONS FOUND THIS MONUMENT AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES USING SURVEY QUALITY G.P.S. EQUIPMENT.
