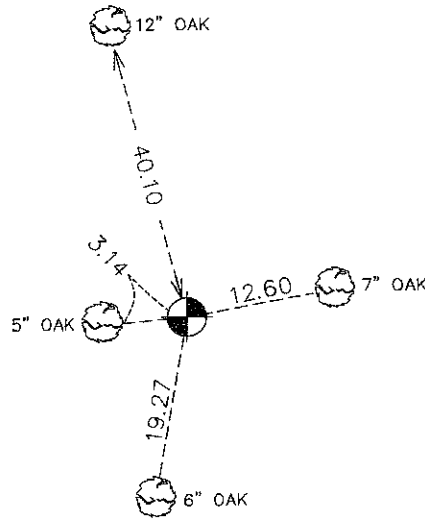

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE: NORTHEAST CORNER 12-41-24 4124011

All of the original bearing trees are now gone.

There is no resurvey data on file for this corner.

On February 2, 1983, M.B. Rude set this corner by single proportional measurement between the east quarter corner of Section 12 and the northeast corner of Section 1.

There is an existing fence corner 100 feet, plus or minus, east and 10 feet, plus or minus, north of this corner.

On December 8, 2011, E.G. Rud & Sons located this monument and established Kanabec County coordinates on this position.
