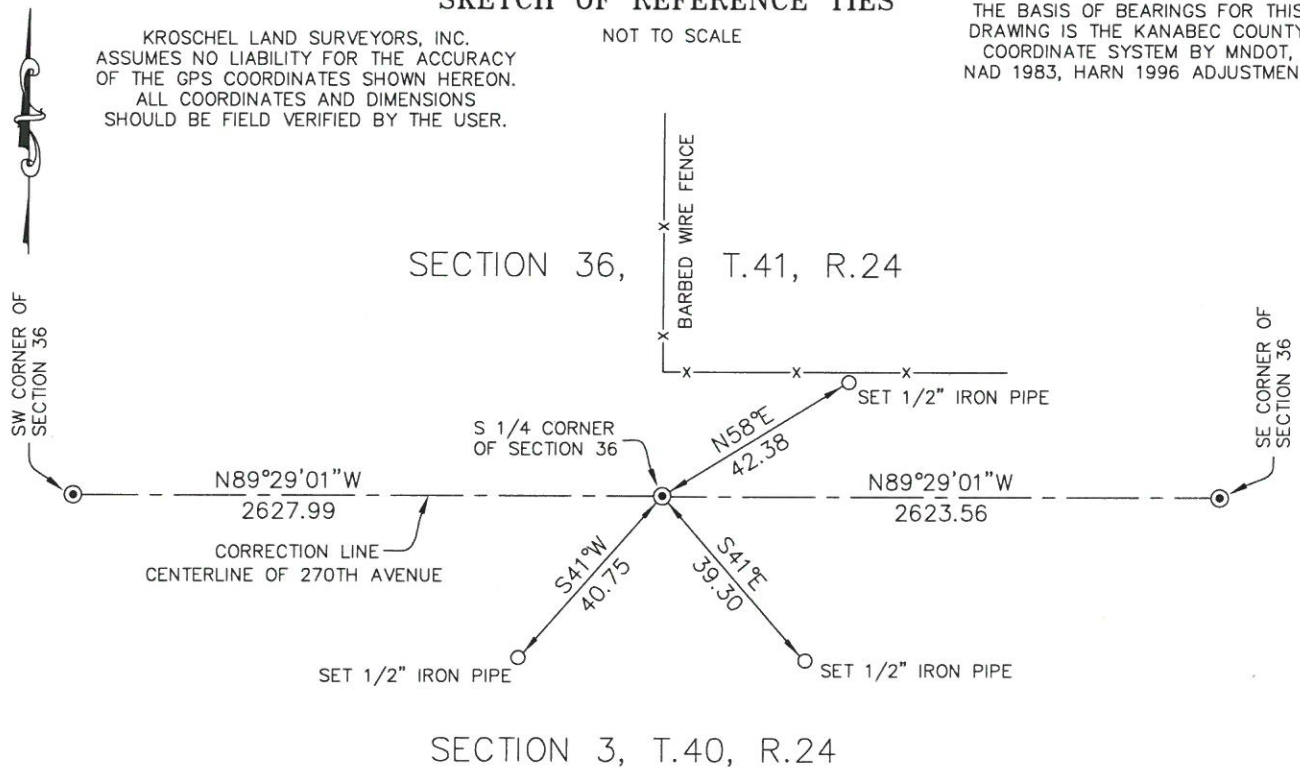

Statement of Evidence:

In November of 1848, Deputy Surveyor Theodore Conkey surveyed the correction line along the south line of Township 41, Range 24, and set a post to mark the South Quarter Corner of Section 36, Township 41 North, Range 24 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

10 inch Birch at North 50 degrees East a distance of 22 links

10 inch Sugar Maple at North 51 degrees West a distance of 22 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

1927—Charles Handschu made a survey of Knife Lake. His map shows corners at the Northeast corner and North Quarter corner of Section 3, T.40, R.24, but he does not show anything for the South Quarter corner of Section 36, T.41, R.24.

In October of 2015, I made a survey around Section 36, Township 41 North, Range 24 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Michael and Sandra Tohey to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 10/08/2015, a search was made by checking with a magnetic locator at the centerline of the County Road and a fence line north. No evidence of the corner was found. The fence line north falls approximately 2.2 feet east of a computed lost position. I set a 1/2" x 14" Iron Rebar with Plastic Cap marked "KROSCHER 44490" on a straight line between the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 36 and at the intersection with the fence line north extended south. I accepted this position as the best available evidence of the original corner monument. This position fits the centerline of the County Road.

No excavation was made as the corner falls in a cut section of the road. Any remaining evidence of the corner would have been destroyed in construction of the road.



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
