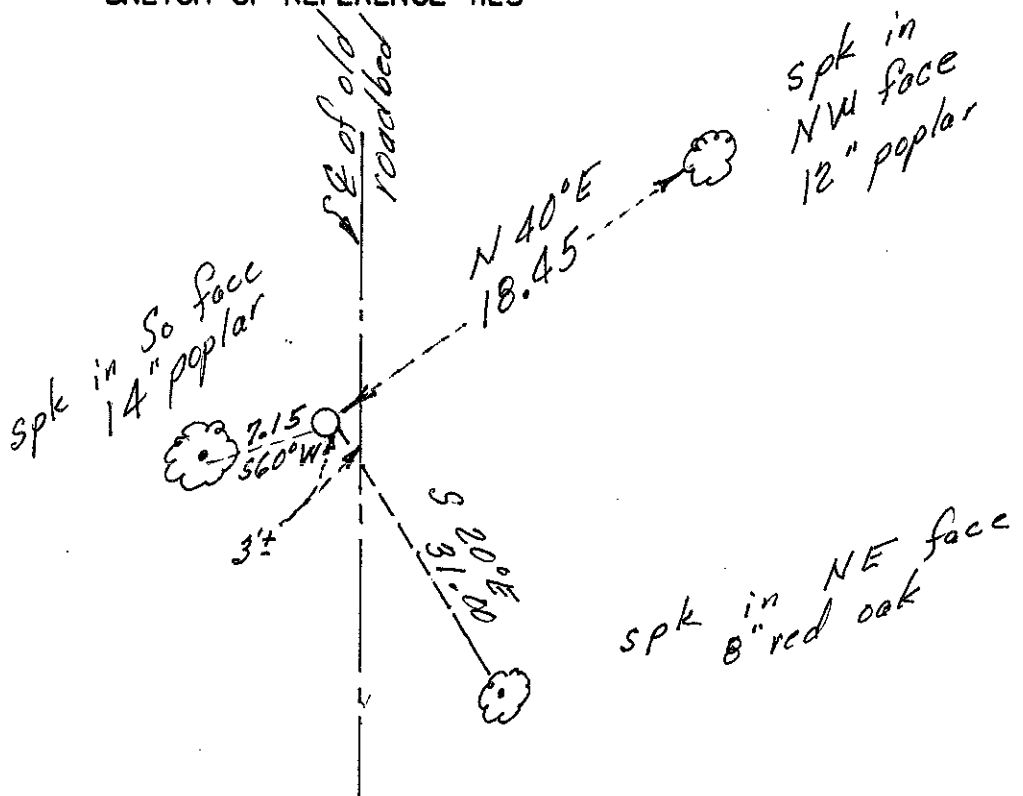

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE: EAST QUARTER CORNER 34-41-24

All of the original bearing trees are now gone.

In 1909, Mr. John Nelson, the County Surveyor, set a marked stone for the West Quarter Corner.

In 1978, Roy Brasch showed M.B. Rude the location where he has seen the stone.

M.B. Rude made an excavation with the backhoe at this location and at 4" below the surface he found a stone with an "X" cut on the top.

He off-set the stone and replaced it with a Cast Aluminum Monument.

On November 13, 2012 E.G. Rud & Sons found this Cast Aluminum Monument under a field stone placed on top. Kanabec County Coordinates were established on this monument and new ties were taken.
