

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE
FROM TIE SHEET 352

FOUND SANDSTONE WHILE DIGGING FOR CORNER WITH BACKHOE. X ON SANDSTONE WAS BROKEN OFF WITH BACKHOE IN PROCESS AND SANDSTONE WAS REPLACED WITH MONUMENT.

SANDSTONE FIT ALL OCCUPATION LINES GOOD AND WAS CLOSE TO THE CENTERLINE OF ROADS NORTH AND SOUTH.

SANDSTONE WAS SET BY JOHN NELSON IN 1904.

IN AUGUST 2004, WE RAN A SURVEY AROUND SECTION 1, 11, 12, 13, AND 14 TO LOCATE EXISTING MONUMENTATION AND TIE IN LINES OF OCCUPATION. WE FOUND THE CAST IRON MONUMENT SET BY M.B. RUDE AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES N THIS CORNER.
