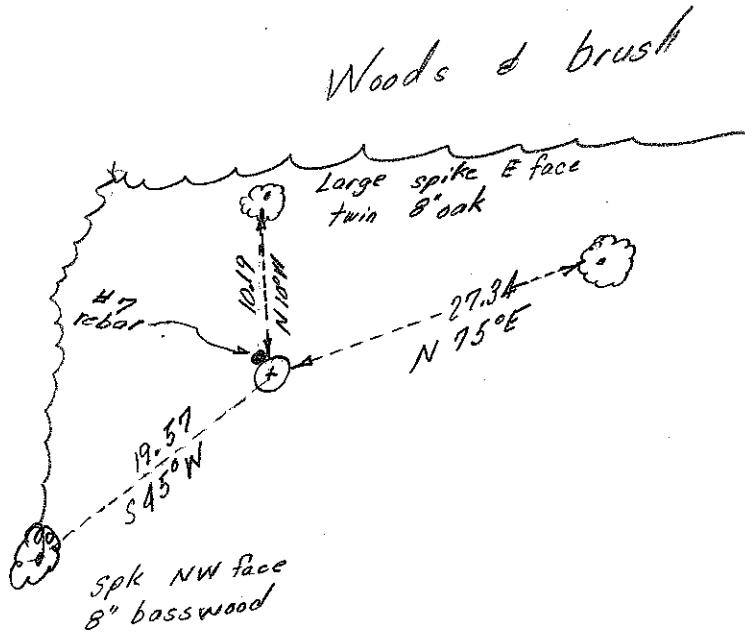

Original corner was set on December 31, 1851 and 4 bearing trees noted as:

24" pine bearing North 36.5 degrees West at 7 links
20" pine bearing South 39 degrees West at 16 links
30" pine bearing North 69 degrees East at 18 links
14" pine bearing South 34 degrees East at 58 links

No evidence to the corner or bearing trees could be found. A stone with a chiseled X was located by Mille Lacs County Surveyor's Office on May 19, 1916 by S. L. Kennedy and 4 ties to pine trees were recorded. No pine trees remain today.

A survey recorded on Page 294 and 295 in Book A of Surveys by John Nelson, dated April 7, 1901 noted this corner being set but doesn't state what was set.

On July 11, 2012, E. G. Rud & Sons did a survey for the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31. Testimony from Steinbreckers (owners of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 31) indicated a stone with an X was found at this corner. This area had been logged off and new poplar growth had grown up. An approximate location was computed and a thorough search made within a 100 foot radius. A stone with and X was finally found in approximate area of logging limits. This fit the description given by Steinbreckers. It also agreed within 8 feet of distance measured by John Nelson to the Northeast corner of Section. An iron rod was set on the Northwest corner of stone, ties taken and Kanabec County coordinates established on this position.
