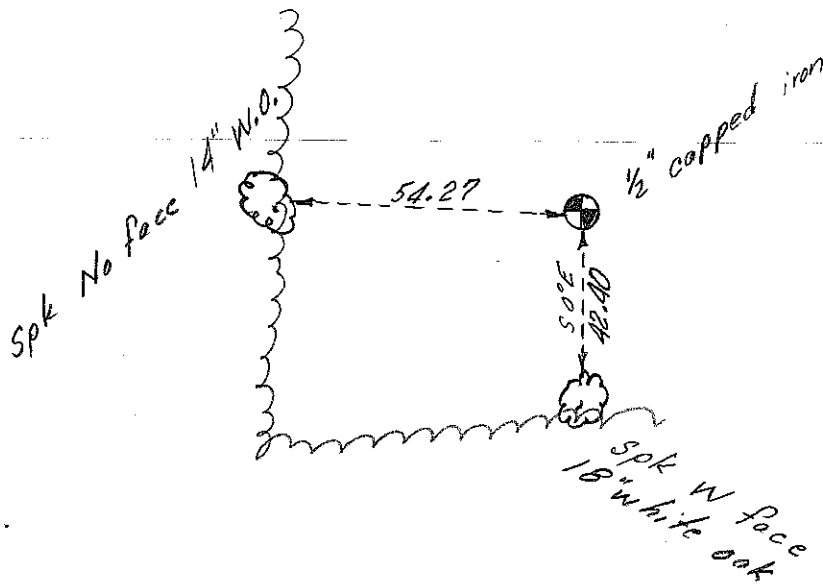

The original government post was set on December 31, 1851 and 2 bearing trees noted as:

16" white oak bearing North 72 degrees west at 76 links

8" white birch bearing South 62 degrees East at 22 links

No evidence for the corner or accessories could be found.

A survey by John Nelson recorded on Pages 294 and 295 in Book A of Surveys indicate a corner post set with ties taken. Search was made for corner and accessories but no evidence could be found.

On July 11, 2012, E. G. Rud & Sons did a survey of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31 and set this corner by lost methods. No evidence of good occupation lines could be found at this corner location. A fence along the north line of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ fell 0 – 6' +/- north of established line. A $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe with a plastic cap marked R.L.S. 9808 was set, ties taken and Kanabec County coordinates established on this position.
