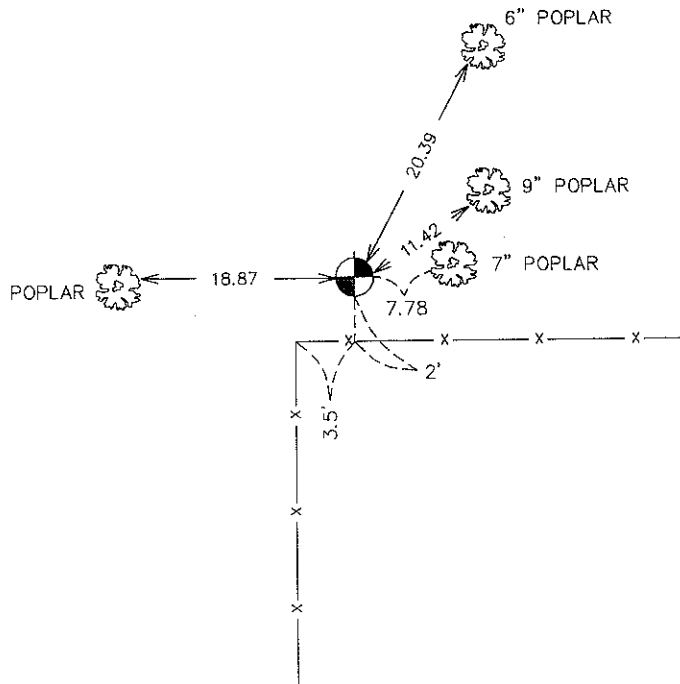

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT POST WAS SET BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR SILAS BARNARD ON JUNE 24, 1855 AND 2 BEARING TREES NOTED: 6" BLACK ASH (S10°W A DISTANCE OF 5 LINKS) AND 8" BLACK ASH (N40°E A DISTANCE OF 12 LINKS). NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE FOR THIS CORNER OR BEARING TREES REMAIN.

IN 1901, FORMER COUNTY SURVEYOR, JOHN NELSON, MADE A ROAD SURVEY IN SEC. 2, BUT HIS RECORDS DO NOT SHOW WHAT WAS USED OR SET FOR THE E 1/4 CORNER.

IN 1949, CHARLES HANDSCHU SURVEYED A NUMBER OF LOTS AND ROADS IN THE NW 1/4 OF SEC. 2. HIS RECORDS DO NOT SHOW WHAT WAS FOUND OR SET AT THE E 1/4 CORNER.

IN MARCH OF 1985, M.B. RUDE RAN A SURVEY AROUND SEC. 2 TO LOCATE THE EXISTING MONUMENTS, LINES OF OCCUPATION AND TO SEARCH THE AREA.

THE IS A FENCE CORNER NEAR THIS CORNER AND IN JULY HE MADE A SEARCH OF THIS AREA, BUT NO EVIDENCE OF A CORNER MARKER.

M.B. RUDE RESET THIS CORNER BY EXTENSION OF MONUMENTS FOUND IN THE NW 1/4 AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SEC. 2 THAT WERE SET BY HANDSCHU AND HANDSCHU'S SECTION MAP WHICH SHOWS ALL THE DISTANCES AND ANGLES AROUND SEC. 2

IN 2009, E.G. RUD AND SONS ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ON THIS MONUMENT.
