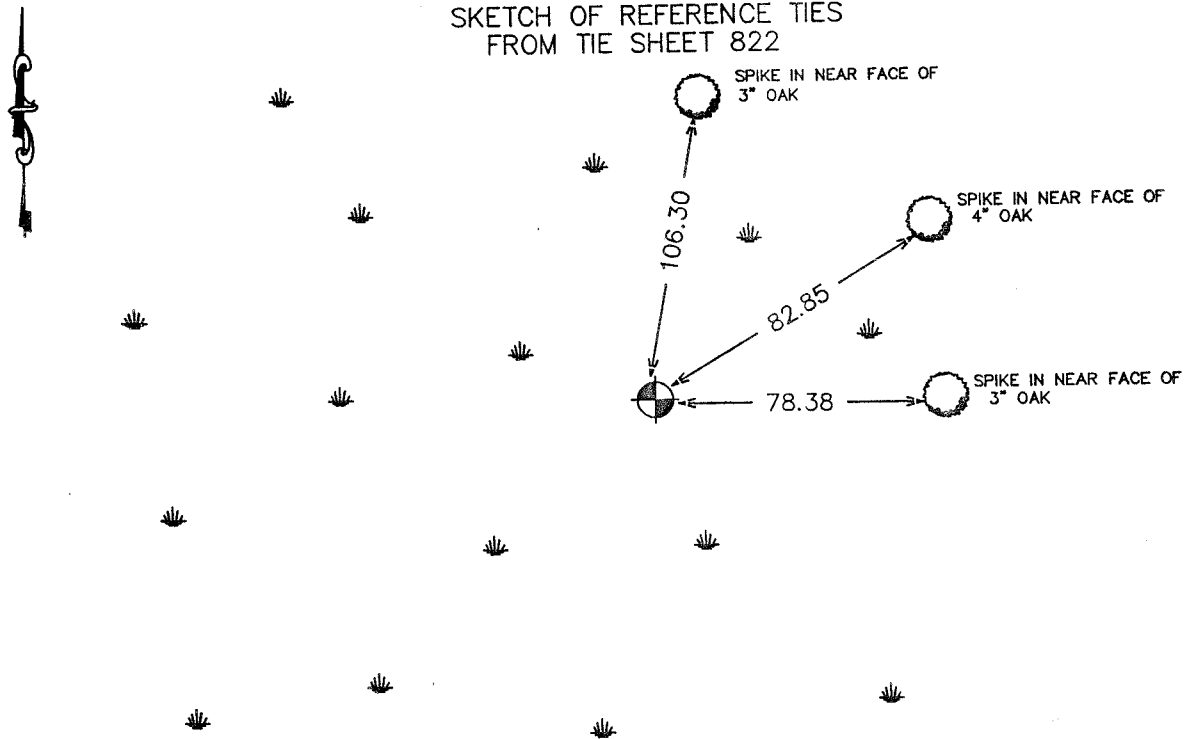

N 1/4 CORNER SEC. 26-39-25

All of the original bearing trees are now gone.

I set this corner by lost methods using the following corner information:
The northwest corner of Section 26, 5.2 feet west of the center line of
State Highway No. 47 per Department of Transportation's notes from 1941

Northeast corner of Section 25, centerline intersection of road north
extended south to centerline of road east

Southeast corner of Section 35, recorded corner on file

Northeast corner of Section 23, recorded corner on file

The computed location of Section 26 by double proportional measurement was
used.

There are no lines of occupation near the northeast and north quarter corners of
Section 26.

In June 2004 we ran a survey around Sections 25 and 26 and found this
monument set by M.B. Rude. We established Kanabec County Coordinates on this
corner using GPS equipment.
