

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 39, RANGE 25

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET BY D.S. SILAS BARNARD ON JULY 5, 1855 AND 2 BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED. NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE FOR THE CORNER POSITION OR BEARING TREES COULD BE FOUND:

IN AUGUST 1979 JEFF CAINE DID A SURVEY IN SECTIONS 8 AND 9 AND FOUND A 1 INCH IRON PIPE DOWN 2 FEET AT THE CENTERLINE INTERSECTION OF COUNTY ROAD 5 AND 10. NO OTHER EVIDENCE COULD BE FOUND. JEFF SET A 1/2 INCH IRON PIPE OVER THE 1 INCH PIPE AND TOOK TIES.

IN JUNE 2007 E.G. RUD & SONS, INC. FOUND THIS MONUMENT AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE STABLISHED ON THIS POSITION USING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (G.P.S.) EQUIPMENT.
