

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 39, RANGE 25

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET BY D.S. SILAS BARNARD ON JULY 6, 1855 AND 2 BEARING TREES WERE ESTABLISHED. NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE FOR THE CORNER POST OR BEARING TREES COULD BE FOUND.

IN AUGUST 1979 JEFF CAINE DID A SURVEY IN SECTION 9 AND EXCAVATED AN AREA 28 FEET EAST-WEST FOR WIDTH OF ROAD AND FOUND NOTHING AT THIS LOCATION. THIS CORNER FALLS AT THE INTERSECTION OF AN EAST-WEST ROADWAY WITH A FENCE RUNNING NORTH. JEFF SET A MONUMENT AT THE INTERSECTION. THIS FALLS WITHIN 12 FEET OF A SPLIT AND 5 FEET OF BEING ON LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST CORNERS OF SECTION 9.

IN JUNE 2007 E.G. RUD & SONS, INC. FOUND THIS MONUMENT AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION USING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (G.P.S.) EQUIPMENT.
