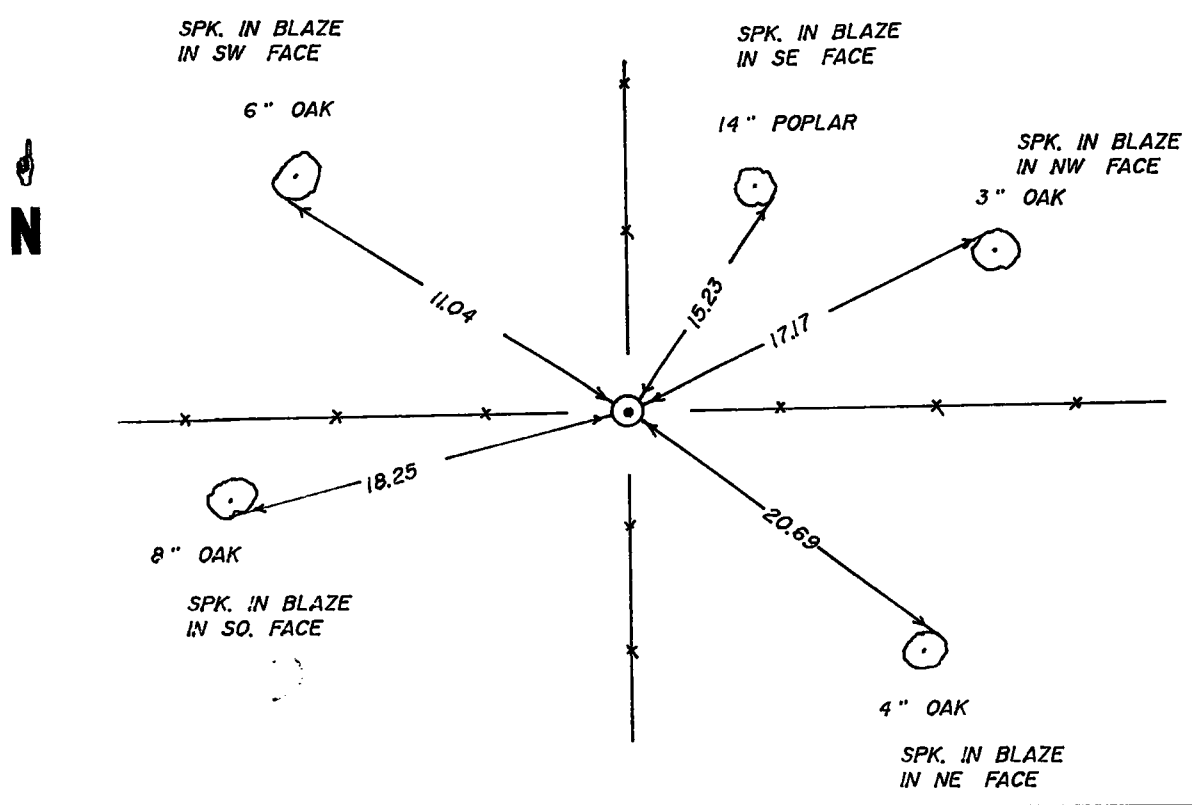

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STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

All of the original government bearing trees are now gone.

Charles Handschu, RLS, made a survey in Section 7, Township 40, Range 23, filed at the Kanabec County Surveyor's Office. There is no date on this survey approximately in the 1930's or 1940's. These records show a post at this corner.

Frank Kvidera, RLS, made a plat in 1968 and his records show a iron pipe at this corner.

In 1975, we found a pinched tip 1/2" iron pipe at this corner at a four-way fence corner and used this location in a survey in Sections 6 and 7, Township 40, Range 23.

On November 21, 1996, I found the pinched 1/2" iron pipe and replaced it with a 7/8" capped rebar at the perpetuated location of this corner.
