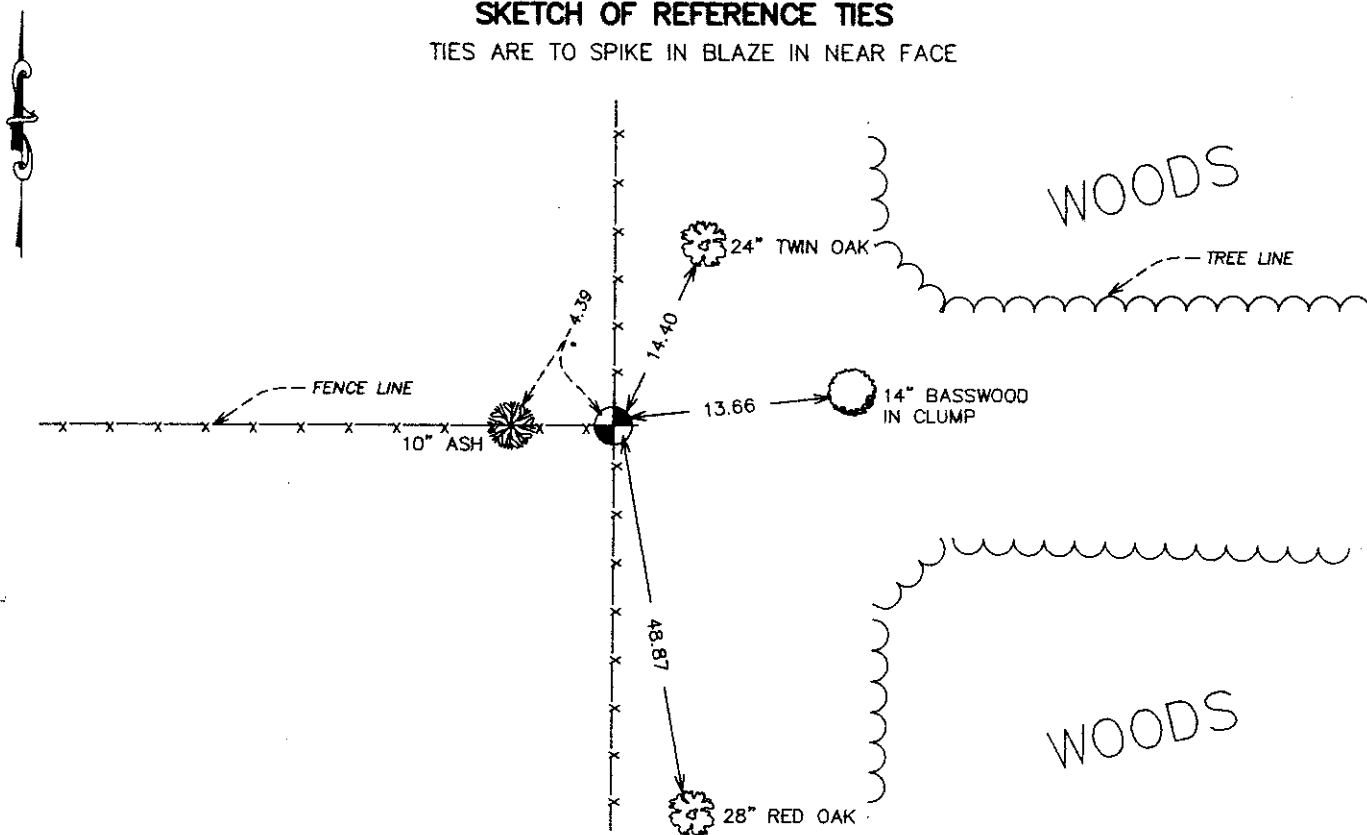

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL GOVERNMENT BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE. THERE ARE NO RE-SURVEY NOTES ON FILE FOR THIS CORNER.

ON FEBRUARY 9, 2005, DALE ANDERSON SEARCHED THE AREA AROUND THE INTERSECTION OF A NORTH-SOUTH FENCELINE AND A FENCELINE ~~RUNNING~~ WEST. NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS FOUND. *running*

ON FEBRUARY 9, 2005 HE SET A 7/8 INCH BY 24 INCH REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KANABEC COUNTY CAP AT THE BASE OF AN OLD FENCE CORNER POST FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE. FOUR REFERENCE TIES WERE MADE TO A SPIKE IN A BLAZE IN THE SIDE OF THE AS SHOWN ON THE CERTIFICATE. THIS POSITION WAS ACCEPTED AS THE PERPETUATED CORNER LOCATION.

ON FEBRUARY 5, 2008 E.G. RUD & SONS, INC. FOUND THIS MONUMENT AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION USING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (G.P.S.) EQUIPMENT.
