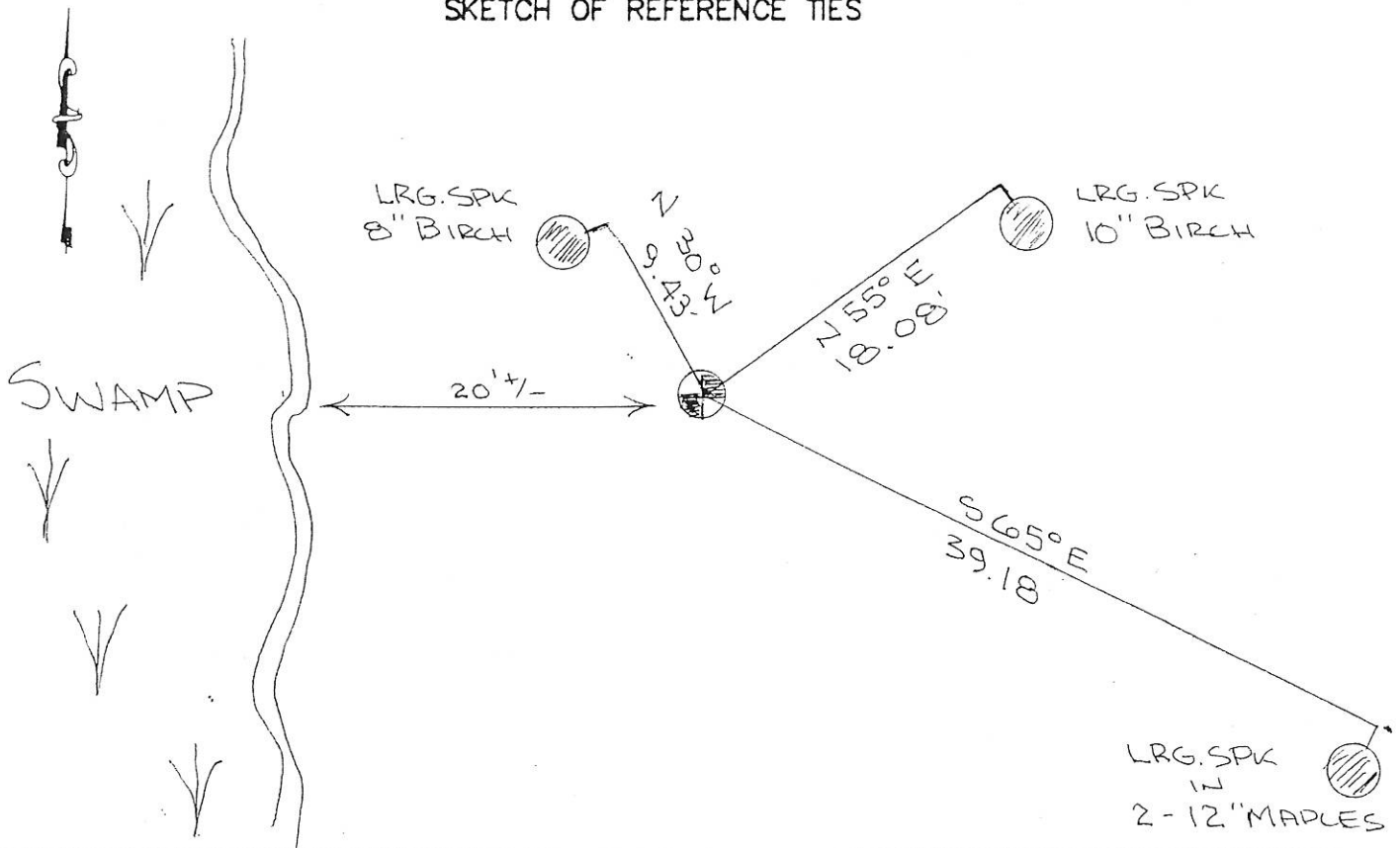

The original Government post was set on October 20, 1855 by Deputy Surveyor Silas Barnard and 2 bearing trees noted as:

10" Poplar bearing North at 24 links

8" Maple bearing South 27 degrees East 20 links

No evidence could be found for the post or bearing trees. There are no lines of occupation in the near vicinity. No records of any previous surveys could be found at the Kanabec County Offices. Therefore we set this corner on line and at a proportional distance between the northeast and the northwest corners of Section 19. A #7 rebar with an aluminum cap was set, ties taken and Kanabec County Coordinates established on this position. A fence post was set close to the monument.
