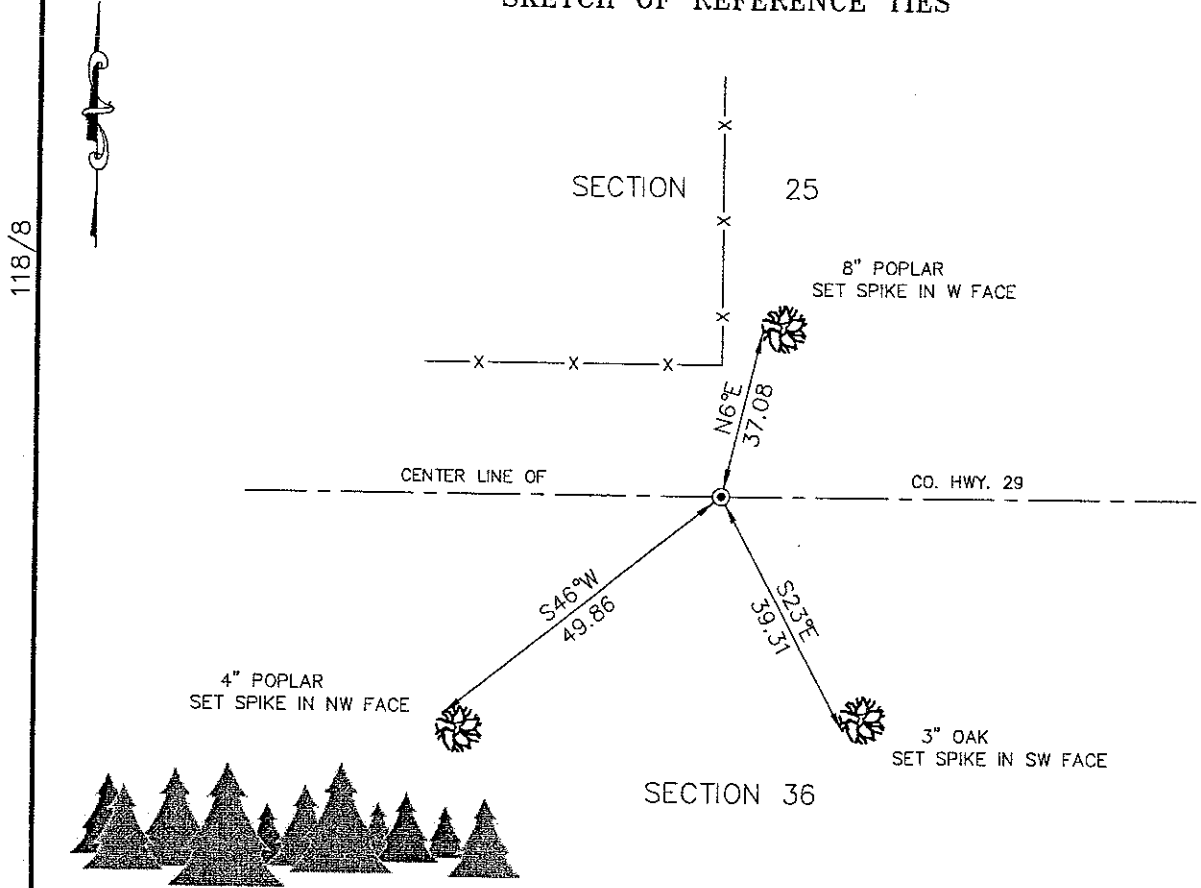

Statement of Evidence:

In November of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the North Quarter Corner of Section 36, Township 42 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

9 inch Tamarack at South 29 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of 3 links
20 inch Aspen at North 66 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 25 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

In Book A, Page 216 of the old survey records located at the County Highway Department, there is an undated survey by J.B. Vickery that shows a measured distances along the north line of Section 36. Mr. Vickery does not state what he found or set.

On 5/15/1901, a Township Supervisor's Road Order was filed in the Office of the County Auditor opening a Township road along the north line of Section 36. Attached to the road order there is a survey of the road that is not signed or dated. The survey shows the same distances as J.B. Vickery's survey in Book A, Page 216. It is assumed that Mr. Vickery made his survey in or before 1901.

In June 2009, a survey was made around Section 26, Township 42 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Mark Hickle to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On June 1, 2009, we found a 3/8" x 18" Rebar at the intersection of the center line of County Highway 29 and a fence line north.

On June 4, 2009 we offset the found Rebar and made a 10' x 15' x 2' deep excavation with Marvin Rostberg's Bobcat. The excavation was centered on the found Rebar. No further evidence was found in the excavation.

The found 3/8" Rebar is determined to be the best available evidence of the original corner monument location. We replaced the found Rebar with a 7/8" x 24" Rebar Monument with Aluminum Cap. Established reference ties and assigned Kanabec County Coordinates.
