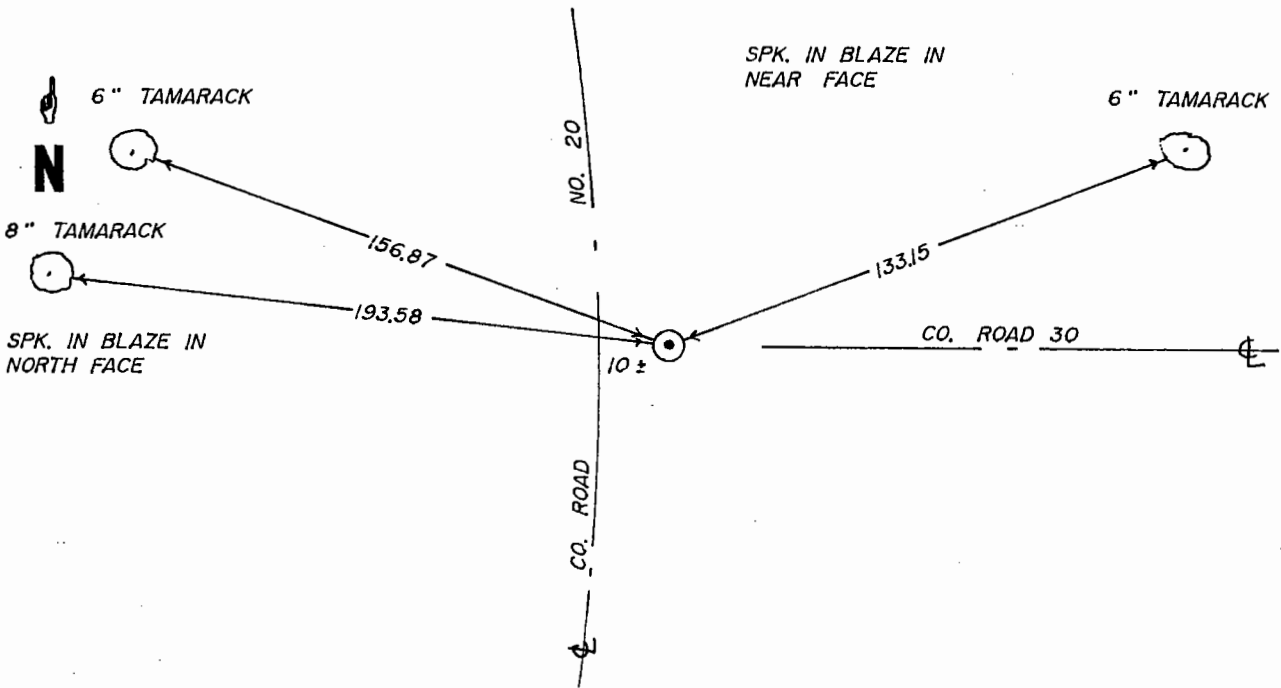

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

All of the original government bearing trees are now gone.

This corner was reestablished by Neubert W. Swanson, a Registered Land Surveyor, in a survey for the plat of DEEPHAVEN in 1961 and used by him in the plat of POINT# ELEVEN in 1970.

In 1975, a survey crew working for the County, under my supervision, found Swanson's monument and replaced it with a cast iron aluminum monument.

On October 5, 1994, we found the cast aluminum monument per the survey records from 1975 and made new reference ties.
