

## Statement of Evidence:

In November of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the North Quarter Corner of Section 14, Township 42 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

12 inch Tamarack at South 48 degrees 45 minutes West o distance of 11 links 9 inch Tamarack at North 43 degrees East a distance of 5 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

1903—Surveyor John Nelson made a survey of several roads in Kroschel Township filed in Book 1 of 2 of Surveys, Page 26, located at the County Highway Department. Nelson measured a distance of 82.36 chains along the north line of Section 14. He did not find or set anything at the North Quarter corner of Section 14.

1903—Township Supervisors Road Order was filed in the office of the County Auditor opening a Township road along the north line of Section 14. There is no survey information attached to the road order.

1957—Chas Handschu, LS 464 made a survey in Section 11 for the plat of Ekdale's Lake Eleven Lots. Handschu set on Iron Monument at the South Quarter corner of Section 11 and measured a distance of 2648.0 feet to the Southeast corner of Section 11.

1961—Neubert Swanson, LS 5709 surveyed the plat of Deep Haven in Section 11. He shows a monument at the South Quarter corner of Section 11 and dimensions around Section 11.

1977—M.B. Rude, LS 8195 surveyed the plat of Kroschel Addition in Section 11. Rude set a 1/2" Iron Pipe at the South Quarter corner of Section 11, using information from the plat of Ekdale's Lake Eleven Lots. No corner certificate was filed.

1982—M.B. Rude, LS 8195 mode a survey in the Southeast Quarter of Section 11 for Vernon Kroschel, Job #1583. Rude found his 1/2" Iron Pipe and measured a distance of 2647.30 feet along the south line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11. No corner certificate was filed.

In July of 2020, I made a survey around Section 14, Township 42 North, Ronge 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Jerry Lee to locate existing monuments and establish search areas.

On 12/16/2020 I made a search with a magnetic locotor at the centerline of the eost/west County Road and 33 feet west of the centerline of the Township Road north. No evidence of the corner was found. I found many of Rude's monuments set in the plat of Kroschel Addition and his survey in the Southeast Quarter of Section 11 (Jab #1583). Using these monuments, I camputed Rude's location and set a 1/2" x 14" Rebar monument with plastic cap marked KROSCHEL 44490. This location fit the centerline of the County Raad east—west and 33 feet west of the centerline of the Township Road north.

This location was determined to be the best available evidence of the original corner monument. Established reference ties and assigned Kanabec County Coordinates. No excavation was made at this location, as the corner falls in a swamp. Any excavation would damage the bed of the County Road.
