STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE.

THERE ISN'T ANY RESURVEY INFORMATION ON FILE FOR THIS CORNER.

THE AREA RESIDENTS HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE CORNER MARKER.

IN FEBRUARY, 1979, M.B. RUDE RAN A SURVEY AROUND SECTIONS 10 THROUGH 15, 22 THROUGH 24, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 24, AND SECTIONS 7, 18 AND 19, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 23, AND LOCATED THE EXISTING LINES OF OCCUPATION AND MONUMENTATION.

IN MARCH, 1981, M.B. RUDE FOUND AN IRON BAR ON THE NORTH SIDE OF A FENCE CORNER WHICH HAS BEEN ACCEPTED AS THE CORNER LOCATION BY THE AREA RESIDENTS AND IS IN HARMONY WITH THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY AND THE OCCUPATION LINES IN SECTION 24.

THERE ARE NO TIE POINTS AVAILABLE.

IN MARCH 2009 E.G. RUD AND SONS RELOCATED THIS CORNER AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES USING G.P.S. EQUIPMENT.
