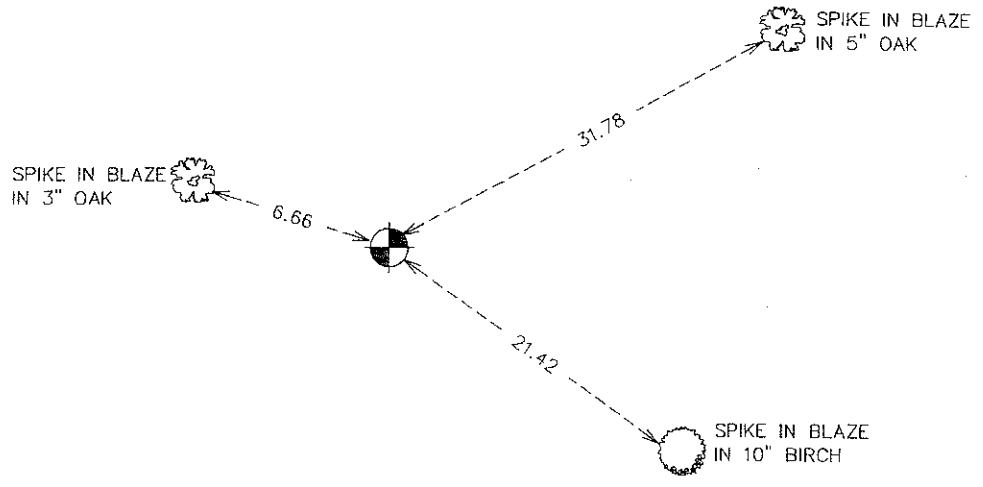

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

OCTOBER 5, 1851 ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR JOHN M. GIAY AND A TAMARACK AND WHITE PINE WERE ESTABLISHED AS BEARING TREES.

NOVEMBER 26, 1974 M.B. RUDE FOUND A 3/4 INCH BY 2 1/2 INCH PIECE OF FLAT IRON 4 TO 5 FEET LONG UP 3 INCHES. THIS FIT LINE AND DISTANCE PER SURVEY RECORDED IN 1928 AT THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.

JUNE 10, 2008 E.G. RUD & SONS, INC. FOUND THIS FLAT IRON AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION USING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (G.P.S.) EQUIPMENT.
