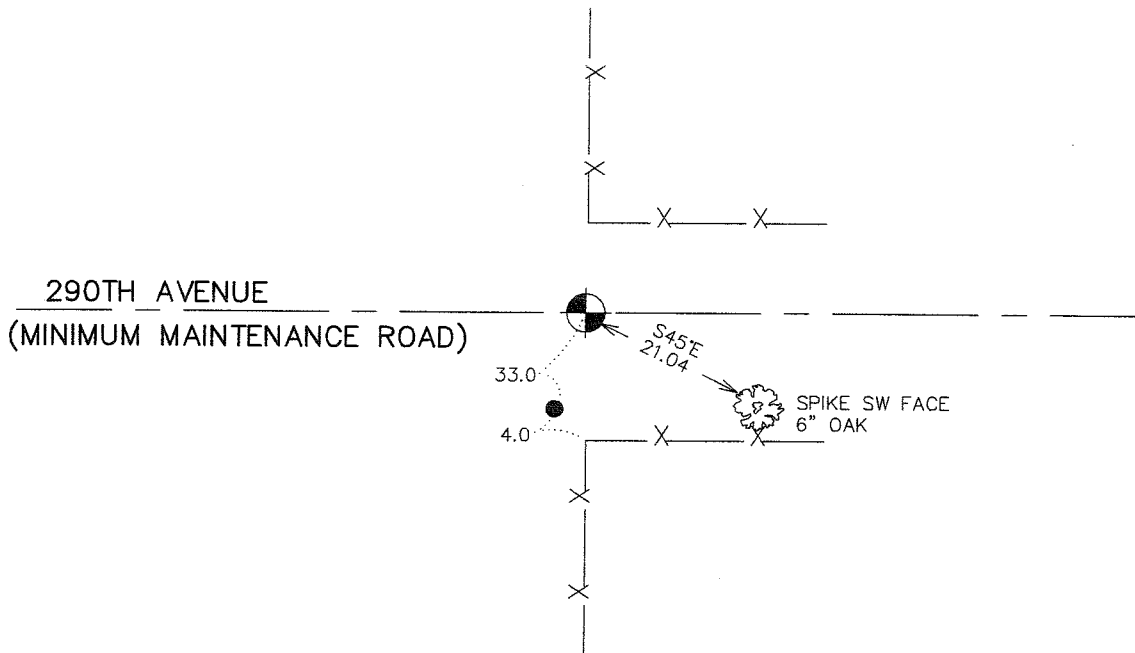

# NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 26, T41, R23

## **STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE**

A WOOD POST WAS SET FOR THE ORIGINAL CORNER AND 2 BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR JOHN M GLEY IN OCTOBER 1851. ANY EVIDENCE FOR THE CORNER OR BEARING TREES NO LONGER REMAIN.

THIS CORNER FALLS ON THE CENTERLINE OF A MINIMUM MAINTENANCE ROAD AND A FENCE LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH.

JAMES VICKEREY DID A SURVEY ALONG THIS NORTH LINE IN 1910 AND RECORDED A DISTANCE OF 80.5 CHAINS (5313 FEET). HE DOES NOT STATE IF A CORNER WAS SET. IN MARCH 2007 E.G. RUD AND SONS DID A SURVEY IN SECTION 26 AND TIED IN EXISTING CORNERS AND LINES OF OCCUPATION. E.G. RUD MEASURED THE NORTH LINE AND CAME UP WITH A DISTANCE OF 5330.62 FEET. THIS CORNER WAS SET ON LINE AND SPLIT AND FIT THE FENCE LINE WITHIN 0.5 FEET AND 1.5 SOUTH OF CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD. A MONUMENT WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP WAS SET AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ESTABLISHED USING G.P.S. EQUIPMENT.
