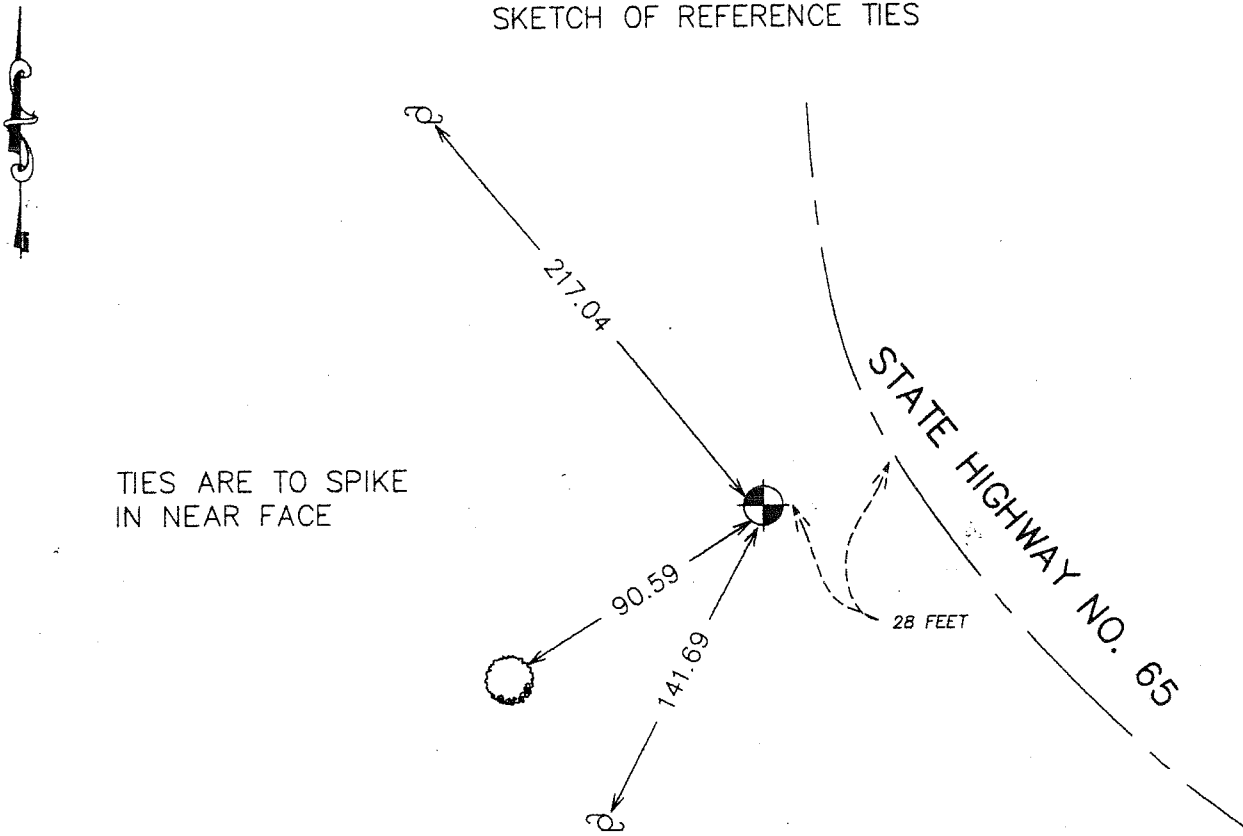

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 23

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE
(FROM TIE SHEET 733)

All of the original bearing trees are now gone.

The State Department of Transportation did not find this corner in their survey for the State Highway No. 65 and all evidence of the original quarter post was destroyed in road construction.

There are no lines of occupation at this corner and the Department of Transportation's right of way map for Highway No. 65 shows this corner to be west of the center line of Highway 65 on a straight line between the section corners.

In July of 1986, M.B. Rude ran a survey around Section 30 to locate the existing monuments and lines of occupation.

In 1956, Byron Lathrop made a survey in Government Lot 1. I found some of his monuments and occupation lines and extended them out to the sixteenth corner between the east quarter corner and the southeast corner of Section 30 which is the northeast corner of Government Lot 1, and found that they fit a straight line between the northeast and southeast corners of Section 30 and the center line of the north-south township road. (Old State Highway No. 65.)

M. B. Rude set this corner on line between the southeast and northeast corners of Section 30 to the northeast corner of Government Lot 1.

On June 26, 2003, E.G. Rud and Sons found this monument and established Kanabec County coordinates on this corner using G.P.S. equipment.
