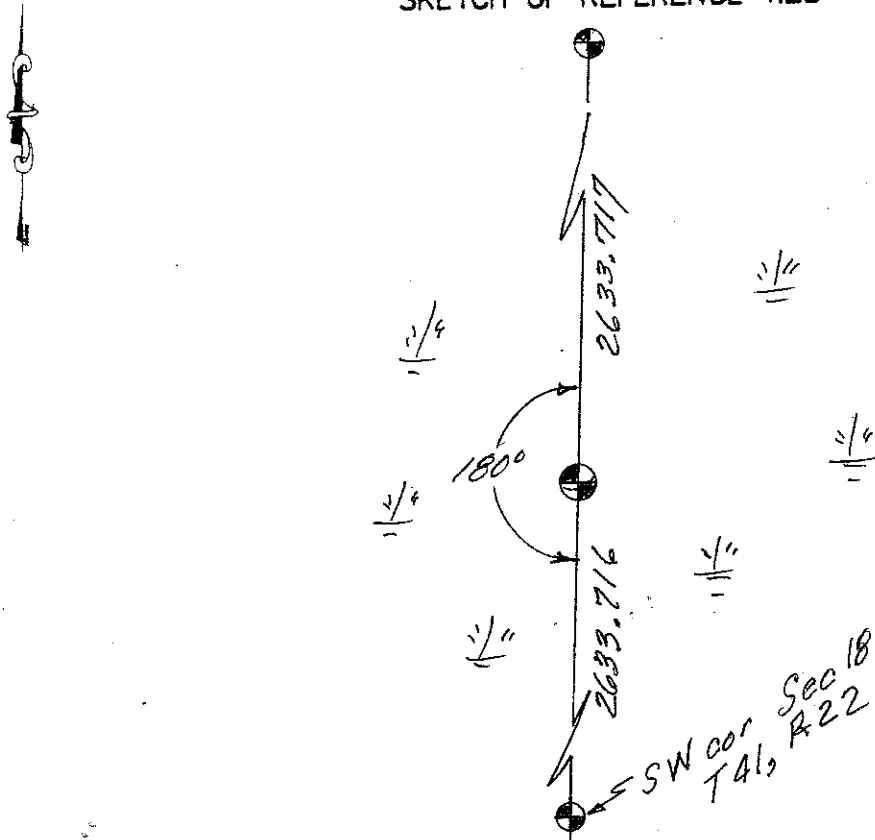

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE: WEST QUARTER CORNER 18-41-22 4122030  
EAST QUARTER CORNER 13-41-23 4123008

The original government corner was set on October 5, 1849 and 2 bearing trees noted as:

8" Tamarack bearing South 3 degrees West at 215 links

7" Tamarack bearing North 82 degrees East at 37 links

No visible evidence could be found for the corner or bearing trees. No record of subsequent surveys could be found at the Kanabec County office.

In March 2004, E.G. Rud & Sons ran a survey along this township line from the Northeast corner of Section 24 to the Northeast corner of the township. This corner falls in a large swamp with no lines of occupation so we treated this corner as set by lost methods. A 7" rebar was set and Kanabec County coordinates established on this position. In January 2012 this position was verified.
