

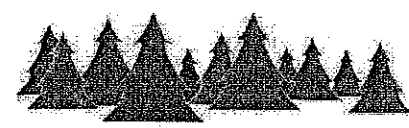
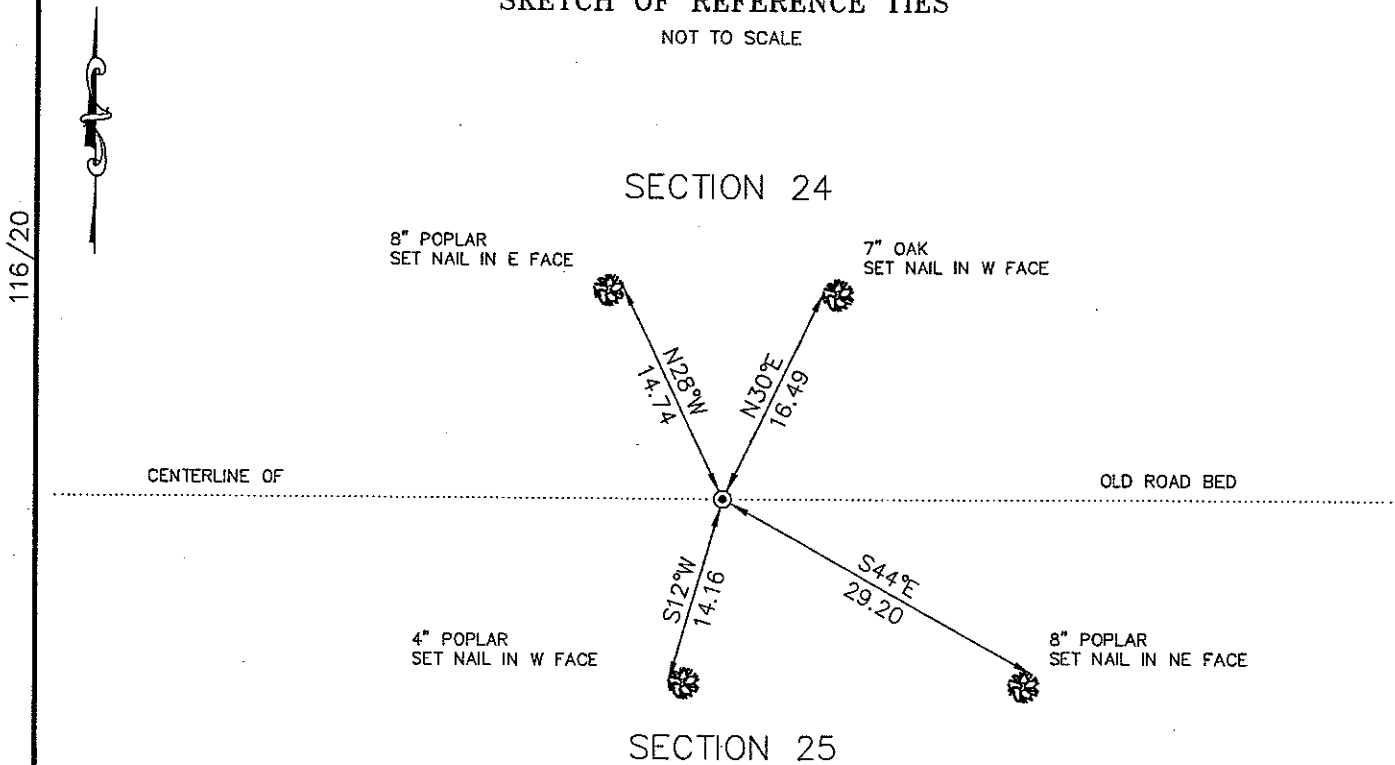
# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Statement of Evidence:

In October of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

- 16 inch W. Birch at South 29 degrees West a distance of 21 links
- 14 inch W. Birch at North 23 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 6 links

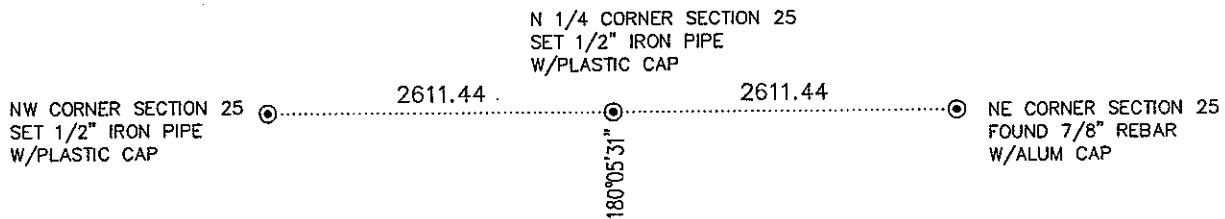
All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

There is no resurvey data available for this corner.

In October 2011, I made a survey around Section 23, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Ray Graber to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 10/24/2011 a 30' x 10' x 3' deep excavation was made with a trackhoe at the center of the old road bed and at a proportional distance between the Northwest and Northeast corners of Section 25. No evidence of the corner was found.

I established this corner at the center line of the road bed and halfway between the Northwest corner of Section 25 and the Northeast corner of Section 25. Established reference ties. This road is shown on a 1962 plat book. Catherine Irlbeck, local resident, testified the road had been there as long as she can remember. She was born in approximately 1921. This location was determined to be the best available evidence of the original corner monument location.
