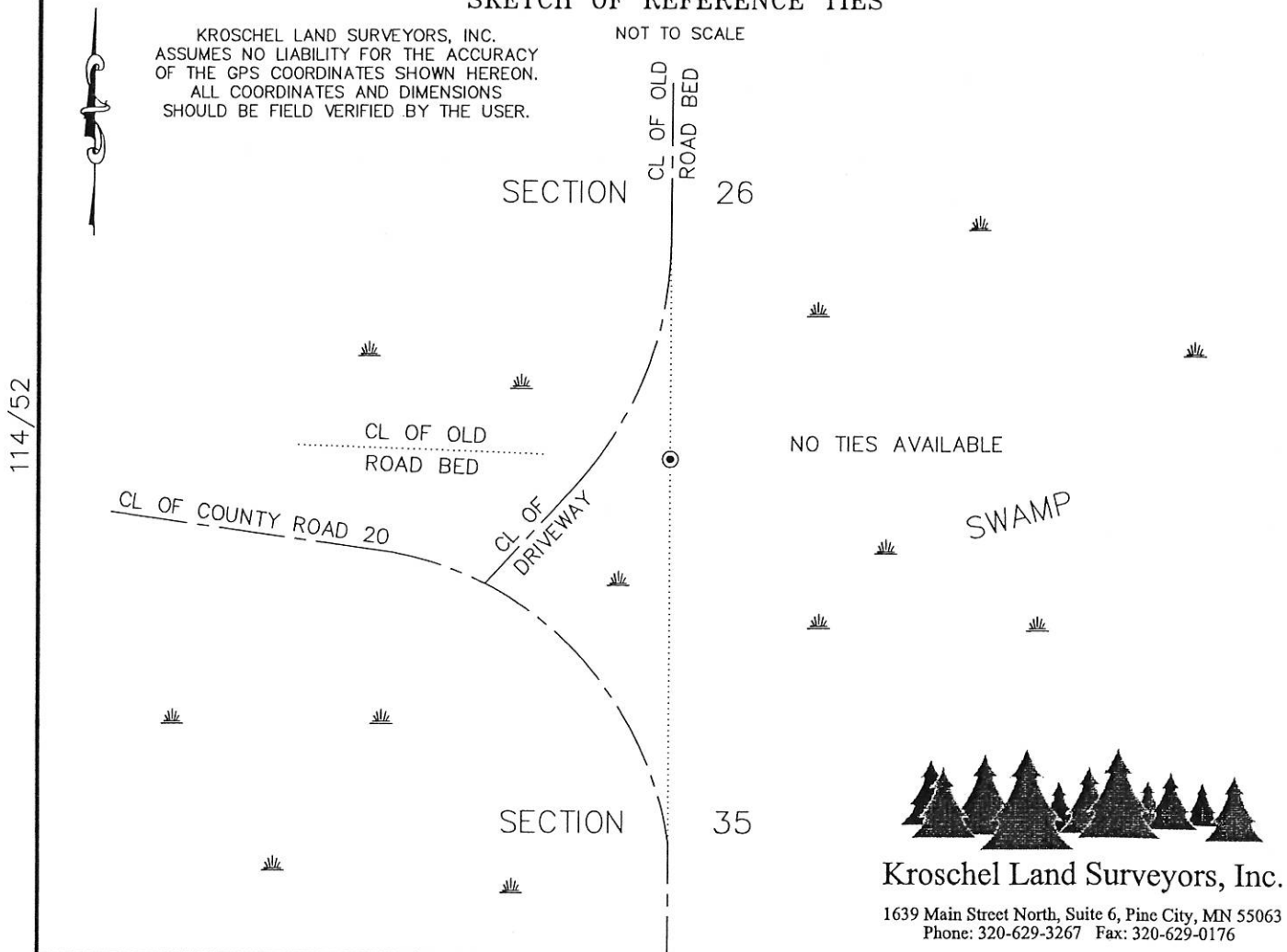



Statement of Evidence:

In October of 1855 Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the North Quarter corner of Section 35, Township 41 North, Range 22 West of the 4th Principal Meridian.

All of the original Government evidence was searched for. None was found.

1902—A Township Supervisor's Road Order was filed in the Office of the County Recorder opening a road along the north-south quarter line of Section 35 and along the north line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35. There is no survey of the road.

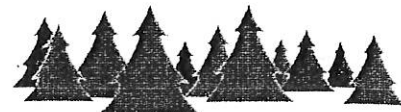
1903—County Surveyor John Nelson made a survey for several roads in Pomroy Township. He records a distance of 80.73 chains to the South Quarter corner of Section 35 and 40.14 chains to the Northwest corner of Section 35.

1917—A Township Supervisor's Road Order was filed in the Office of the County Recorder opening a cartway along the north-south quarter line of Section 26. There is no survey of the road.

In December 2013 I made a survey around Sections 34 and 35, Township 41, Range 22 for Jerry Hennessey to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 12/3/2013 I made a search with a magnetic locator at the intersection of an old road bed west and the extension of the County Road south and old road bed north. No evidence of the corner was found. I set a 7/8"x 72" Rebar monument with Aluminum cap at the extension of the centerline of the old road bed west with the County Road south and old road bed north. I fit Nelson's distance to the south within 11 feet and Nelson's distance to the west within 7 feet. Assigned Kanabec County coordinates.

This location was determined to be the best available evidence of the original government corner monument location. No excavation was made at this location.
