SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES

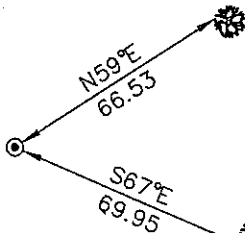

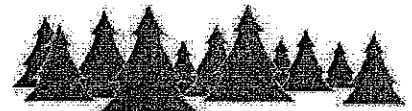



Statement of Evidence:

In October of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the North Quarter Corner of Section 26, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

- 9 inch Balsam at North 27 degrees 15 minutes West a distance of 3 links
- 16 inch Sugar at South 15 degrees East a distance of 10 links

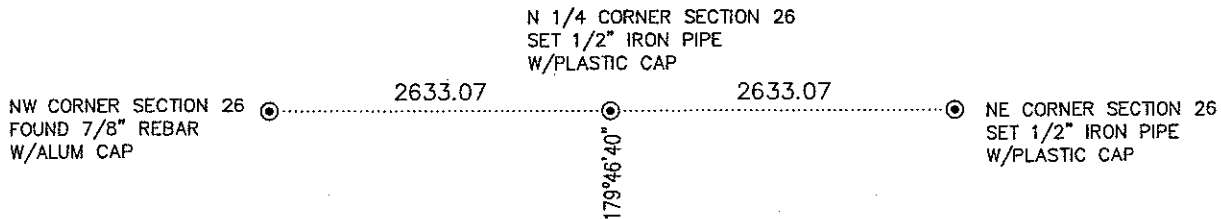
All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

There is no resurvey data available for this corner.

In October 2011, I made a survey around Section 23, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Ray Graber to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and establish search areas.

On 10/26/2011 I made a search with a magnetic locator and by probing the ground. No evidence of the corner was found. The area appears to have been disturbed by cultivation.

There is evidence of an old road bed to the west of this corner. This road is shown on a 1915 plat book. Ray Graber, land owner, testified that it was a township road at one time. I set the corner on the easterly extension of the road bed and halfway between the Northwest and Northeast corners of Section 26. Established reference ties. This location is determined to be the best available evidence of the original corner monument location.



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
