

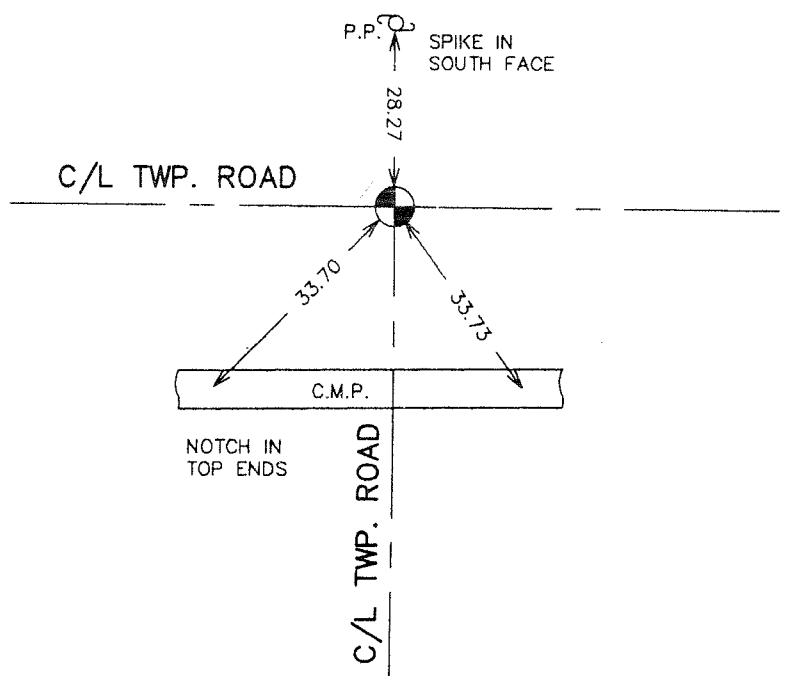

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

ALL OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES ARE NOW GONE.

THERE IS NO RESURVEY DATA ON FILE IN THE COUNTY OFFICE FOR THIS CORNER.

HAROLD KNUTSON, OWNER OF LAND TO THE WEST AND A RESIDENT SINCE 1939, SAID THAT ED SCHULTZ, ONE OF THE BROTHERS THAT HE BOUGHT THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 21 FROM, SAID THERE WAS A SANDSTONE MONUMENT AT THIS CORNER AND IN 1958 ED SCHULTZ CAME UP FROM MINNEAPOLIS TO SHOW HAROLD KNUTSON AND HIS SON, LARRY, WHERE THE STONE WAS SO A TOWNSHIP ROAD COULD BE BUILT TO THE SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE. THE SANDSTONE MONUMENT WAS FOUND IN THE EXISTING EAST-WEST ROAD AND WITNESSED BY ROY TOKLE, ED SCHULTZ, HAROLD, ROY AND LARRY KNUTSON.

IN NOVEMBER OF 1960, G.E. MILLNER, A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR, FOUND THE STONE MONUMENT IN PLACE AND SET AN IRON PIN ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STONE. MR. MILLNER USED THIS LOCATION IN A SURVEY IN SECTION 28.

ON NOVEMBER 30, 1989, M.B. RUDE FOUND THE SANDSTONE WITH A HOLE DRILLED INTO THE TOP AND THE IRON PIN ON THE NORTH SIDE.

THIS LOCATION WAS ACCEPTED AS THE PERPETUATED LOCATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.

IN SEPTEMBER 2006 E.G. RUD AND SONS FOUND THIS IRON PIPE AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES ON THE MONUMENT USING G.P.S. EQUIPMENT.
