



North Quarter Corner, Section 10, Township 41, Range 22

Original corner was set by Government Surveyor Barker in October 1855. No evidence of the original corner or bearing ties remains.

In 1903 John Nelson (County Surveyor) surveyed several roads in Pomroy Township with this corner being on those roads. Survey is recorded in Book A, Page 25 of surveys.

On September 19, 2003 EG Rud and Sons surveyed along some of these same section lines tying in corners, setting control and locating occupation lines.

On October 3, 2003 EG Rud and Sons excavated a 8' x 20' hole .5' feet into natural ground at the centerline of a gravel road and old fence lines running south and north from the point. We found no evidence of a stone set by John Nelson in 1903. We accepted the intersection of the fence lines with the center line of the road as the best location for this corner. We set a #7 rebar 24" long with an aluminum cap. Took ties and established Kanabec County coordinates on the corner.
