

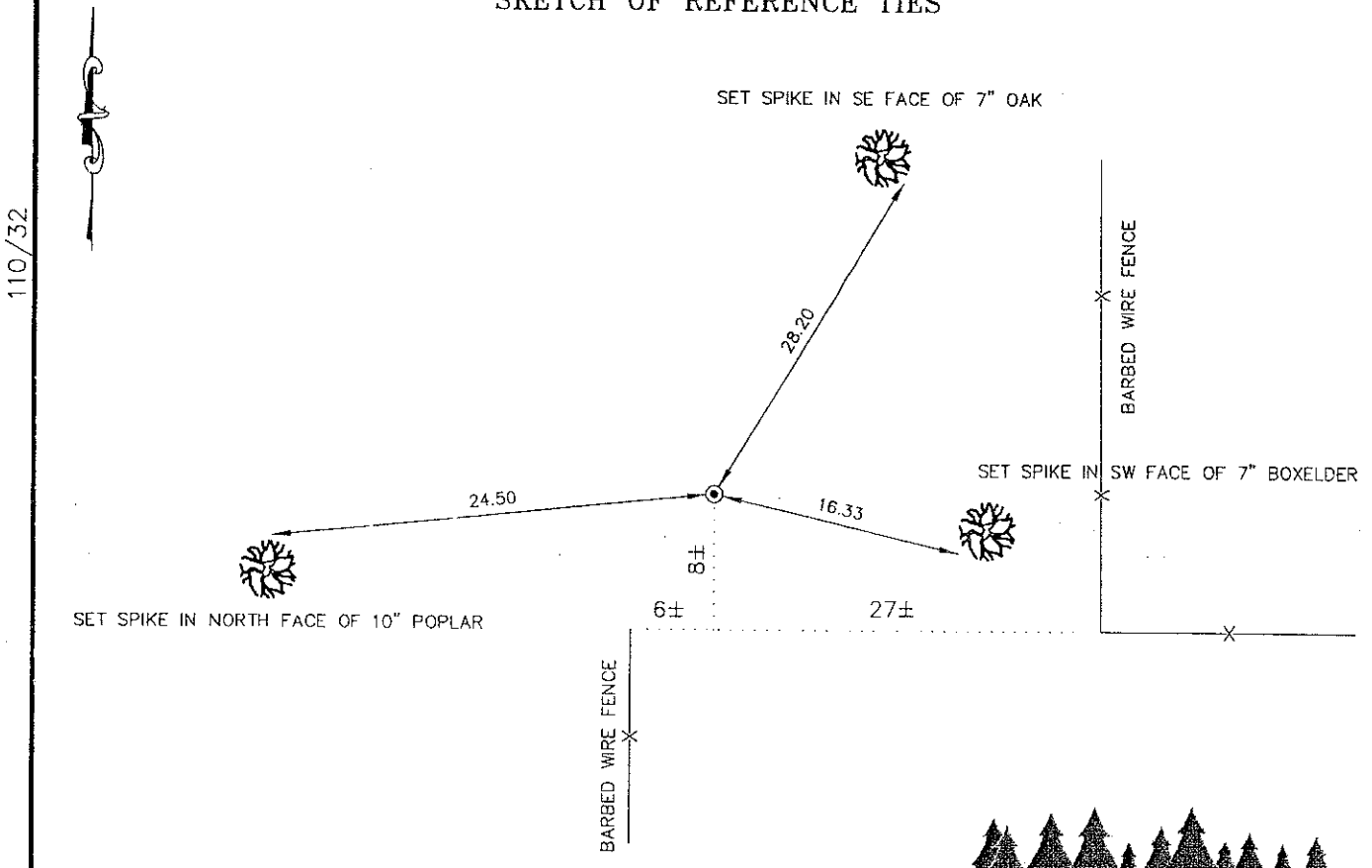
# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Statement of Evidence:

In November of 1855, Deputy Surveyor Isaac Banker set a post to mark the East Quarter Corner of Section 4, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian.

Reference ties were taken to:

- 10 inch White Birch at North 51 degrees East a distance of 10 links
- 12 inch White Birch at South 64 degrees West a distance of 10 links

All of the original Government corner evidence was searched for. None was found.

1909--Surveyor John Nelson made a survey along the east line of Section 4. He set a stake at the East Quarter corner of Section 4. He measured 38.06 chains to the Southeast corner of Section 4 and 54.32 chains to the Northeast corner of Section 4.

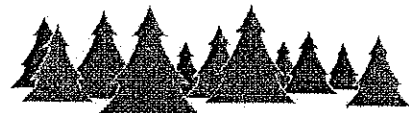
1982--Surveyor Terry Johnson, RLS 13115, made a survey in the Southeast Quarter of Section 4. Mr. Johnson's notes show he set an Iron Pipe at the East Quarter corner of Section 4 using a very old fence line to the east and west. No corner certificate was filed.

2002--Surveyor John Rengo, RLS 25344, made a survey for Steve Westphal in the Northwest Quarter of Section 4 (Government Lots 3-6). Mr. Rengo's crew found a 1/2" x 14" Iron Pipe at the East Quarter corner of Section 4 which fit Terry Johnson's measurements very well. They replaced the found Iron Pipe with a 7/8" x 36" Rebar Monument with Aluminum Cap and made ties. No corner certificate was filed. This location is approximately 95 feet south of John Nelson's computed location. A search was made at Nelson's location, but no evidence of the corner was found.

In March 2010, a survey was made around Section 4, Township 41 North, Range 22 West, 4th Principal Meridian for Bob Hessenius to locate existing monuments.

On 3/29/2010 I found a 7/8" Rebar Monument with Aluminum Cap per Mr. Rengo's field notes. Checked ties and assigned Kanabec County Coordinates.

The found Rebar was determined to be the best available evidence of the original corner location. We measure 2417 feet± (Nelson: 2511.96 feet) to the Southeast corner of Section 4. We measure 3690.70 feet (Nelson: 3585.12 feet) to the Northeast corner of Section 4.



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
